## **Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)**

## Statement of Income and Expenditure for 2016/17

In the 2016/17 financial year Bath & North East Somerset Council received a total of £1,545,852 in respect of CIL from liable developments. The administration allowance was £77,293. This was used to defray CIL administration and continuing set-up costs. The strategic proportion of the CIL received in 2016/17 was £1,236,814. This was transferred to the CIL Strategic Reserve and carried forward unspent to 2017/18. At 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 the CIL Strategic Reserve showed a credit balance of £1,309,248 which included £72,434 transferred in 2015/16 and not yet spent. The neighbourhood proportion of the CIL received in 2016/17 was £231,746. Of this, £162,839 related to developments in the Unparished Bath Area. This was transferred to the CIL Local Reserve and carried forward unspent to 2017/18. At 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017 the CIL Local Reserve showed a credit balance of £1,72,835 which included £9,996 transferred in 2015/16 and not yet spent. The remaining £68,907 related to neighbourhood CIL from developments in the area of various Parish and Town Councils and was distributed as shown below (2015/16 figures in italics):
