


These delightful gardens are Bath's most centrally situated park. Overlooking the River Avon they give fine views of Robert Adam's Pulteney Bridge and the weir, especially from the colonnade built early in the last century.

The bedding displays are among the finest in the country and the annual 3-dimensional floral feature in the summer is always fun. Concerts are held in the bandstand throughout the summer months and children's entertainment is provided during the summer holidays. Deck chairs are available.
