2018/19 BUDGET

Your Money—2018/2019

The money needed for the budget comes from the precept raised, a grant of £4260 from B&NES Council and income. Paulton Parish Council has raised a precept of £210,807 for 2018/19. This is an annual charge of £109 for a Band D property in Paulton which equates to £2.10 per week. The Parish Council has kept this at the same level as 2017/18. A breakdown of how this will be spent is shown below.
