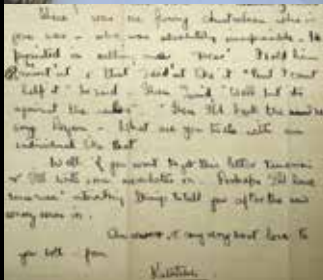

AUTUMN 2018 MARKS THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE END OF THE FIRST WORLD WAR. FROM 1-13 OCTOBER, BATH & NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL PRESENTS THE LAST CHANCE TO SEE **WW1 REMEMBERED, A CENTENARY EXHIBITION TELLING THE STORIES OF LOCAL PEOPLE WHOSE LIVES WERE CHANGED FOREVER BY THE CONFLICT.**

The displays give a unique glimpse into the world of those who served – in uniform and on the home front – through memories, photographs, and letters shared by family members and local organisations.

The exhibition was first shown in Bath in 2014, and then toured to Radstock in 2015, Keynsham in 2016, and Midsomer Norton in 2017. It now returns to Bath for the last time as the Centenary draws to a close.

The exhibition is free of charge to visitors during normal library opening hours at Bath Central Library, The Podium, Bath, from 1 – 13 October.
