F1. Pegasus (on behalf of Robert Hitchens Ltd and J S Bloor Ltd) indicate that the Core Strategy would create a shortfall of 7% against the housing requirements of RPG10 to 2016 (mainly because of under delivery to date). Would such a shortfall amount to the plan not being in general conformity?

H) Duty to co-operate (section 110 of the Localism Act 2011)

H1. Subsequent to the Pre Hearing Meeting, I indicated in ID/8 that new section 20(5)c of the 2004 Act did not apply to this Examination. This view has been challenged in a legal submission made on behalf of Robert Hitchens Ltd. A response has now been made by the Council. Any final comments on whether section 20(5)c applies?
