

**Timeline and History** 

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### 1. Introduction

The Core Strategy sets out the policy framework for the location and level of new housing and other development and is one of the Council's key policy documents.

The project was launched in 2007 and a number of stages took place before the Core Strategy was submitted for examination and subsequently adopted by the Council in 2014. These were to help the Council develop plans that incorporated evidential needs with the views of the public, businesses and organisations. Each stage was subject to a public consultation.

In order for the plans and policies to become part of the Development Plan (against which planning applications are determined) the document had to be examined by the independent Planning Inspectorate, which took place between 2011 and 2013.

This document details the various stages, consultations and evidence relating to the Core Strategy from its launch to its adoption in 2014, all of which can be accessed via the hyperlinks within it.

# 2. The Launch of the Core Strategy



The process of developing the Core Strategy began with the 'Issues and Options' Stage. A <u>Launch Document</u> was produced that set out to stimulate discussion on how the district of Bath & North East Somerset should develop over the following 20 years.

A consultation on the <u>Core Strategy Launch Document</u> took place between 25th September and 17th December 2007, for which the following documents were produced:

<u>A report on the Core Strategy Launch Consultation</u> followed. This set out the community involvement and work that took place, and summarised the issues raised amongst the approximately 3,000 comments received from around 300 people/groups during the consultation.

# 3. The Spatial Options



The Council published the <u>Core Strategy Spatial Options Document</u> in the autumn of 2009, prepared in the context of, and generally conformed with, the draft Regional Spatial Strategy (RSS) for the South West (which was subsequently revoked).



An extended period of public consultation and engagement on the Core Strategy Spatial Options took place between 19<sup>th</sup> October 2009 and 11<sup>th</sup> December 2009. 3,029 comments were made by 327 respondents during the consultation, and are summarised in <a href="teleport-on-the-Core Strategy Spatial Options Consultation">the Core Strategy Spatial Options Consultation</a>. As with the previous and future reports on the consultations that took place, the report set out the community involvement and work that took place.

# 4. The Draft Core Strategy



The Draft Core Strategy, which contained the Council's proposed strategy, was published in December 2010 and consulted upon in January and February of 2011. This was the final stage in developing the planning document before submitting it for examination in public by the Planning Inspectorate.



## 5. The Submitted Core Strategy




The Draft Core Strategy was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for examination on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2011 following a number of changes to the Draft Core Strategy that had been consulted upon. These changes had been approved via the delegated arrangements agreed by Council at its meeting on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2010, and are shown within the <u>Schedule of Proposed Changes to the Draft Core Strategy (March 2011)</u>.

The Council also produced a version of the <u>Draft Core Strategy incorporating the Proposed</u> Changes.

# 6. The Core Strategy Examination



Following the submission of the <u>Draft Core Strategy</u> to the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2011 PINS appointed Simon Emerson to conduct the examination. At the same time, Chris Banks was appointed as the Programme Officer for the Examination Hearings. As the Programme Officer, Chris Banks acted as a liaison between the Inspector, the Council and others participating in the Hearings.

#### **6.1 Preparing for the Examination**

The Examination began with the Inspector undertaking a preparatory stage in which he outlined his preliminary comments and questions:

The Council response was set out in the following documents:

The Inspector agreed to hold the Examination Hearings in January 2012 (see ID/2 and ID/4). The Council wrote to interested parties confirming the date of the hearings, as well as the date of the Pre-Hearing Meeting (see <u>BNES/3</u>).

A Pre-hearing Meeting took place on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2011, principally to discuss the administrative arrangements and procedures for the Examination Hearings. It aimed to help the Inspector and all the interested parties prepare for the Examination. The Inspector outlined how he would conduct the Examination

#### 6.2. The Examination Hearings in 2011 and 2012

The Examination Hearings began on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

The Inspector issued a programme for the hearings, along with a series of issues and questions he is sought to address through the hearings ( $\underline{ID/7}$ ). The Inspector also issued a supplementary note to the Main Issues and Questions document ( $\underline{ID/8}$ ), and a note regarding consideration of the Bath Flood Compensation Scheme issue at the Examination Hearings ( $\underline{ID/9}$ ).

In response to ID/7 the Council submitted a number of statements (BNES/5 to BNES/13) as well as a number of Statements of Common Ground/Agreement (BNES/14 to BNES/20) which set out areas of agreement between the Council and various participants in the hearings. All of the subsequent notes issued by the Inspector during all stages of the Examination Hearings can be viewed within Appendix 2. Corresponding responses and notes issued by the Council can be viewed in Appendix 3.

Participants in the hearings were invited by the Inspector to submit statements responding to the questions asked by the Inspector. These statements can be viewed in Appendix 5.1. One of the participants, Pegasus Planning on behalf of Robert Hitchens Ltd, submitted Ian Dove QC's legal opinion on Section 110 of the Localism Act and SEA (available via this link), to which the Council responded with BNES/21 and BNES/23. Further statements made by examination participants in 2012can be found within Appendix 5.1.

# 6.3 Changes to the Core Strategy during the Examination Hearings (September 2011)

During the Examination the Council suggested some changes to the Submitted Core Strategy. These changes arose through discussion at the Examination Hearings or through consideration of comments by the Inspectors or objectors. Changes that the Inspector considered were needed to overcome concerns about soundness of the submitted Core Strategy were included in his final Report and then formally considered by the Council and subject to consultation after the Hearings.

At its meeting on 15th September 2011 the Council agreed to publish a <u>Schedule of Significant Proposed Changes to the Submitted Core Strategy (September 2011)</u> for comment between 19th September and 21st October 2011.

The Planning Inspector asked for comments on the potential implications of the Government's then recently published <u>draft National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF)</u> and Policy for <u>TravellersTravelers'</u> Sites (<u>ID/27</u>). The Council responded to ID/27 with <u>BNES/38</u>.

The Council identified potential further changes which would be required to the Core Strategy should the NPPF be finalised by Government before the examination ends. These are set out in a <u>Schedule of Potential Changes arising from the Draft NPPF</u>.

Subsequent to the consultation, The Council received a note from the Inspector outlining his preliminary conclusions on strategic matters and way forward (Ref  $\underline{\text{ID}/28}$  and  $\underline{\text{ID}/30}$ ). Following the Council's response ( $\underline{\text{BNES/39}}$ ) the Inspector agreed to suspend the Examination (see  $\underline{\text{ID/29}}$ ).

# 6.4 Changes to the Core Strategy during the Examination Hearings (March 2013

A <u>Schedule of Proposed Changes to the Submitted Core Strategy (March 2013)</u> was agreed by the <u>Council on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2013</u> (see item 89) and published between 26th March and 8th May 2013 for public comment. Due to the amendment to Policies 3A and 3B only being publicised on 19<sup>th</sup> April the consultation period in relation to this issue was subsequently extended by 2 weeks until 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2013.

Comments could be submitted on the proposed changes and on the alternative options which were considered by the Council but rejected (see the Council Report Appendix 1 link for details of options considered but rejected). The changes were consulted on and the responses were sent to the Inspector.

It should be noted that <u>the Schedule of Proposed Changes to the Submitted Core Strategy</u> was revised to correct errors in the previous version. These were as follows:

- Minor changes to SPC126 and SPC129 to give greater clarify in relation to housing supply in the Somer Valley (this does not affect the Core Strategy Policies for the Somer Valley)
- Change to development requirement a) for both Policies B3A and B3B to specify the proportion of affordable housing that will be sought in development at land adjoining Odd Down and Weston (see change references SPC88 and SPC89)
- Change to Policy B2(4)(h) that was originally discussed at the Hearings in February 2012 and agreed by Council on 4th March 2013 was previously omitted in error. See change reference SPC69A.
- Revision to Diagram 4 (Key Diagram) to correctly show the number of jobs in the Somer Valley reflecting the amended Policy SV1 (change reference SPC130).

<u>Supporting Evidence</u> to the Schedule of Proposed Changes to the Submitted Core Strategy was made available. It included the Concept Option Reports produced as a result of work by Ove Arup & Partners to investigate locations for potential development through the Core Strategy.

# 6.5 Changes to the Core Strategy during the Examination Hearings (November 2013)

Following the previous changes and consultation the Planning Inspector asked the Council to provide more detail about the proposed developments and changes to the Green Belt in the following areas of the district:

- Odd Down/South Stoke, Bath
- Weston, Bath
- East Keynsham
- South West Keynsham
- Whitchurch

In order to address the Inspector's concerns around clarity of the proposals and housing delivery the Council defined the boundaries of the five strategic sites. This includes amendments to the Green Belt boundaries. It was previously envisaged that this work would be undertaken in the Placemaking Plan but in light of the Inspector's concerns, this work was brought forward into the Core Strategy. This means that the strategic sites will now not be considered in the Placemaking Plan. Please note that these amendments do not relate to the principle of releasing land in these locations.

Comments were invited on the strategic site allocations and the placemaking principles relating to their development and to the related Green Belt boundary changes. Comments were also invited on alternative site and boundary options. This enabled all the changes to be tested through the Examination process:

- The amendments to the Core Strategy were set out in a '<u>Schedule of Core Strategy</u> Amendments
- A <u>Core Strategy Newspaper (November 2013)</u> was produced summarising the changes to these areas and the Core Strategy.
- A <u>composite version of the Submitted Core Strategy which incorporates the Proposed Changes March 2013 and Amendments November 2013.</u>

A significant amount of evidence base work was done to inform site allocations and much of this was published on 13<sup>th</sup> September 2013 as part of the Examination process. <u>This and any additional evidence informing the site allocation details are available via this link</u>. The evidence was also available within the <u>Core Documents List (Appendix 1, reference CD/10 onwards)</u>.

#### 6.6. The Examination Hearings in 2014


The Examination Hearings resumed on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2014 following the <u>Programme set by the Inspector</u> (the agenda for each session can be found within <u>Appendix 2</u>, ID/46 to ID/48B). The Inspector issued <u>ID/44</u> and <u>ID/45</u> on the progression of the Core Strategy Examination Hearings, and an update for the Hearings on National Planning Policy Guidance and on Minister's letters on Inspectors' reports concerning the Green Belt (<u>ID/49</u>). The Council responded to ID/44 with <u>BNES/53</u> (explaining the information submitted to the Inspector for the Hearings commencing in March 2014) and ID/45 with <u>BNES/54</u>.

A number of <u>Statements of Common Ground (see BNES/53a to BNES/53ac in Appendix 3)</u> were prepared by the Council and the various landowners/developers/promoters of the Green Belt sites proposed for allocation in the Core Strategy amendments.

The Council and other Examination Participants submitted <u>new evidence</u> to the Inspector in advance of the Hearings commencing in March 2014 (also available within the <u>Core Documents List in Appendix 1</u>). A number of statements were been submitted by Participants at the Hearings and are available within <u>Appendix 5</u>.

The Examination Hearings ended on 10<sup>th</sup> April, after which the Inspector retired to consider the evidence submitted and statements made, and to write his report recommending whether the Core Strategy should be adopted with or without any further changes.

# 6. The Adoption of the Core Strategy



<u>The Planning Inspector published his Final Report</u> on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2014 in which he found the Core Strategy sound subject to a number of modifications:
