DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2024**

This Order is made by Bath and North East Somerset Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs that the Somerset County Council, Bathavon Rural District and Keynsham Urban District Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Bath and North East Somerset Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 18<sup>th</sup> April 2024.
2. The Somerset County Council, Bathavon Rural District and Keynsham Urban District Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA8/93, Park Copse, Compton Dando) Definitive Map Modification Order 2024.

A public footpath commencing from a junction with the carriageway of Peppershells Lane at grid reference ST 6419 6493 (Point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally west-south-westerly direction for approximately 18 metres to grid reference ST 6418 6492 (Point B on the Order Map) and turning in a generally southerly direction through Park Copse for approximately 210 metres to a junction with public footpath BA8/65 at grid reference ST 6420 6474 (Point D on the Order Map).
