

Please note that all representations received will be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it will become available for public inspection.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
