Wildlife + Countryside Act 1981: PROW Submission

Track: Gnr Dpts 752.3/634 to 751/634.3

Further to my letter of 4th October, 1982, and your note received 29-4-83, each of the 25 in no. Perrymead/Lyncombe Vale residents has been approached and all except one have no objection to their PROW sheet being seen by Dr Simpson and his solicitor. The exception is [redacted] (Sheet No 23) of [redacted]

2. If my letter of 4th October 1982 is sent to Dr Simpson, therefore, you must remove the last sheet of it, which lists those persons signing PROW sheets (+ obviously included [redacted]) as well as Sheet 23 itself.

3. I have enclosed also a new Sheet 2 to my letter of 4th October, 1982. This new sheet deletes the sentence re [redacted] using horses over the track. Please insert this new sheet and delete the original if you send the letter to Dr Simpson (or his successors - see next paragraph)

4. The Bath + West Evening Chronicle carried a prominent report on page 1 of its Wed. 11th May '83 edition stating that Dr Simpson has sold Lyncombe House School to the Paragon School, Bath, and that the schools 'will combine in September'. The only Paragon School personnel referred to in the report are a

[redacted]. The Bath & District Weekly Advertiser for Thursday 12 May '83 also carries a report on page 1 stating that "The Paragon Trust" have purchased Lyncombe House from Dr. Simpson.

3. Please do not include this letter with any papers you send to Dr. Simpson (or his successors) in view of paras 1 and 3 above.
