The above Order made on 2nd August 2017 has been confirmed by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs subject to modifications.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the bridleway commencing from a junction with St Catherine Lane at grid reference ST 7611 7106 and continuing in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 200 metres along a track to the county boundary with South Gloucestershire at grid reference ST 7624 7121.

The order came into effect on 19th December 2019 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, within forty two days from the date of this notice make an application to the High Court.
