Good afternoon Helen,

I wish to lodge an objection, on behalf of the owners of the land, to the Inspectors proposed modification on the following grounds;

1. The Inspector, whilst accepting that attending motorists recollection of their use was misremembered, placed undue weight on written witnesses statements who claimed horse and cycle use.
2. If the witnesses, whose written statements he relied upon, had attended the Inquiry we would have been able to effectively dismiss their claims as well.
3. New witnesses have now come forward who can personally testify that the then owners of the land did make clear that use, limited as it was, was permissive and that this was made clear to all lawful users that they were award of.

We look forward to a second inquiry and request that the Inspector requires that users he relied upon give oral evidence so it can be challenged.
