
**(BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC CL23/41, BURLEDGE)  
(5 FEET WIDTH RESTRICTION) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES) ORDER 2012**

The Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order:

1. This order comes into operation on the 27th November 2012 and may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Byway Open To All Traffic CL23/41, Burledge) (5 Feet Width Restriction) (Prohibition Of Motor Vehicles) Order 2012.
2. In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, "motor vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads.
3. Subject to Article 6 or Article 7, it is prohibited for any vehicle, the width of which, inclusive of any load on or being drawn by the vehicle, exceeds 5 feet, to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1.
4. It is prohibited for any motor vehicle to proceed in any of the parts of road specified in Schedule 2.
5. The Council is satisfied that the provisions of section 3(1) of the 1984 Act shall not apply to this order because it is required for preventing damage to the road or buildings on or near it.
6. The provisions of Article 3 will be suspended as and when the traffic signs are covered and a notice, issued by the Council, is displayed at each end of each part of the road to which the suspension applies.
7. Nothing in Article 3 applies to any vehicle which is being used;
  - (i) with the permission of or as directed by a Police Constable in uniform;
  - (ii) with the prior written permission of the Council; or
  - (iii) by any owner, occupier or lessee of land adjacent to the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1.

## SCHEDULE 1

### 5 Ft Width\* Restriction

#### **Byway Open to All Traffic CL23/41, Burlledge**

That part which is hatched blue on the Order Map and which commences from a junction with Burlledge Lane (Class 4 Highway) adjacent to Hart's Farm Cottage at grid reference ST 5765 5838 (Point A on the Order Map) and continues in a generally east-northeasterly direction following a sunken lane for approximately 810 metres to a junction with Burlledge Common (Class 4 Highway) adjacent to Burlledge Common (registered Common Land) at grid reference ST 5841 5856 (Point B on the Order Map)

## SCHEDULE 2

### Prohibition of Motor Vehicles

#### **Byway Open to All Traffic CL23/41, Burlledge**

Those parts which are shaded red and labelled on the Order Map:

- (i) 'X' (centred on grid reference ST 5786 5845 and totalling approximately 0.309 hectares);
- (ii) 'Y' centred on grid reference ST 5798 5896 and totalling approximately 0.033 hectares); and
- (iii) 'Z' (centred on grid reference ST 5801 5846 and totalling approximately 0.088 hectares)
