

FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of Public Footpath CL4/18, Mill Lane, in the Parish of CHEW STOKE.

Public Footpath (FP) CL4/18 commencing from its junction with Mill Lane at grid reference ST 5567 6175 (point A on the plan) continuing in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 65 metres to grid reference ST 5563 6181 (point B) and continuing in a northerly direction for approximately 82 metres to grid reference ST 5558 6187 (point C) would be stopped up, as shown on the plan by a continuous red line. The new line of the FP would commence from the same point at its junction with Mill Lane continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 26 metres to grid reference ST 5566 6178 (point D) and continuing in a northwesterly direction for approximately 126 metres to point C, as shown on the plan by a continuous green line.

The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the Act'). These changes are proposed in the interests of the landowner in order to route the FP away from the enclosed residential garden onto a route which is already in use by the public. It is intended to authorise a gate at the field boundary at point D under section 147 of the Act to prevent the ingress and egress of livestock.
