PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

This order is made by Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The owners have agreed to defray any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.


BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Pensford and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up from the date that the authority certifies that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new path described in Article 3 into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. No statutory undertakers rights are affected by this order.
3. There shall on the date that the authority certifies that the works to bring the site of the path described in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public have been completed to the reasonable satisfaction of the authority, be a public footpath over the land situate at Pensford described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of a section of Public Footpath CL17/5 commencing from grid reference ST 6255 6276 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally east southeasterly direction for approximately 109 metres to its junction with Birchwood Lane at grid reference ST 6266 6271 (point B on the Order Map).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A section of public footpath commencing from grid reference ST 6255 6276 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally south southeasterly direction for approximately 88 metres to its junction with Birchwood Lane at grid reference ST 6261 6269 (point C on the Order Map).

Width: 2 metres between grid reference ST 6255 6276 (point A on the Order Map) and grid reference ST 6261 6269 (point C on the Order Map).
