

FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

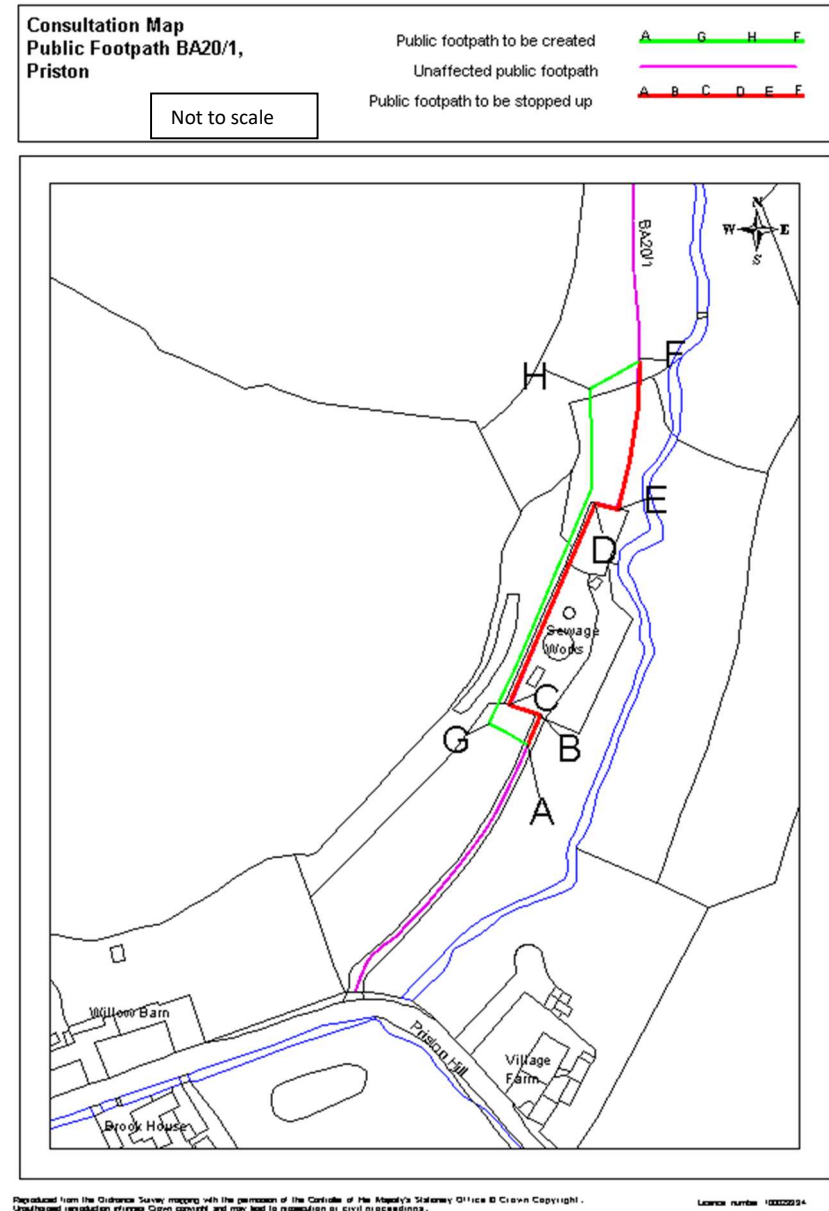
Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of Public Footpath BA20/1, near Priston Sewage Works, in the Parish of Priston.

The general effect of the proposal is shown on the attached Plan. Public Footpath (FP) BA20/1 is currently shown on the Definitive Map as following the boundary of the Sewage Works. However, the definitive line is too close to the boundary to walk in practice. A permissive path has been available for some time and this forms the basis of the proposed route. The section of FP BA20/1 to be stopped up runs from point A on the Plan at grid reference ST 6979 6062 via points B, C, D and E to point F at grid reference ST 6982 6074 and is shown as a continuous red line on the Plan. The proposed FP runs from point A, via points G and H to point F and is shown as a continuous green line on the Plan. The public already generally walk the majority of this route.

The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the Act') and are proposed in the interests of the landowner in order to improve land management and provide a practical route for public use.
