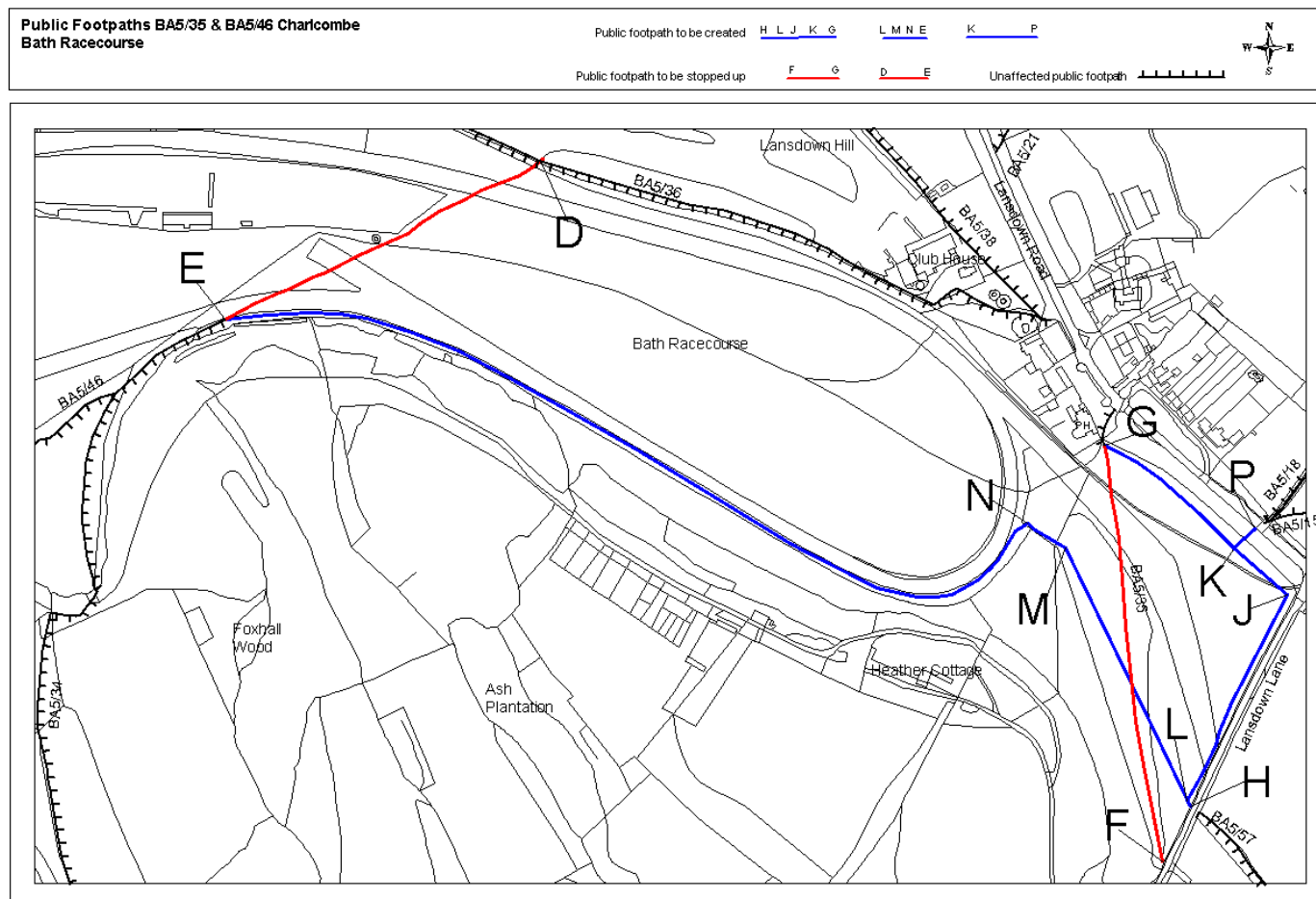


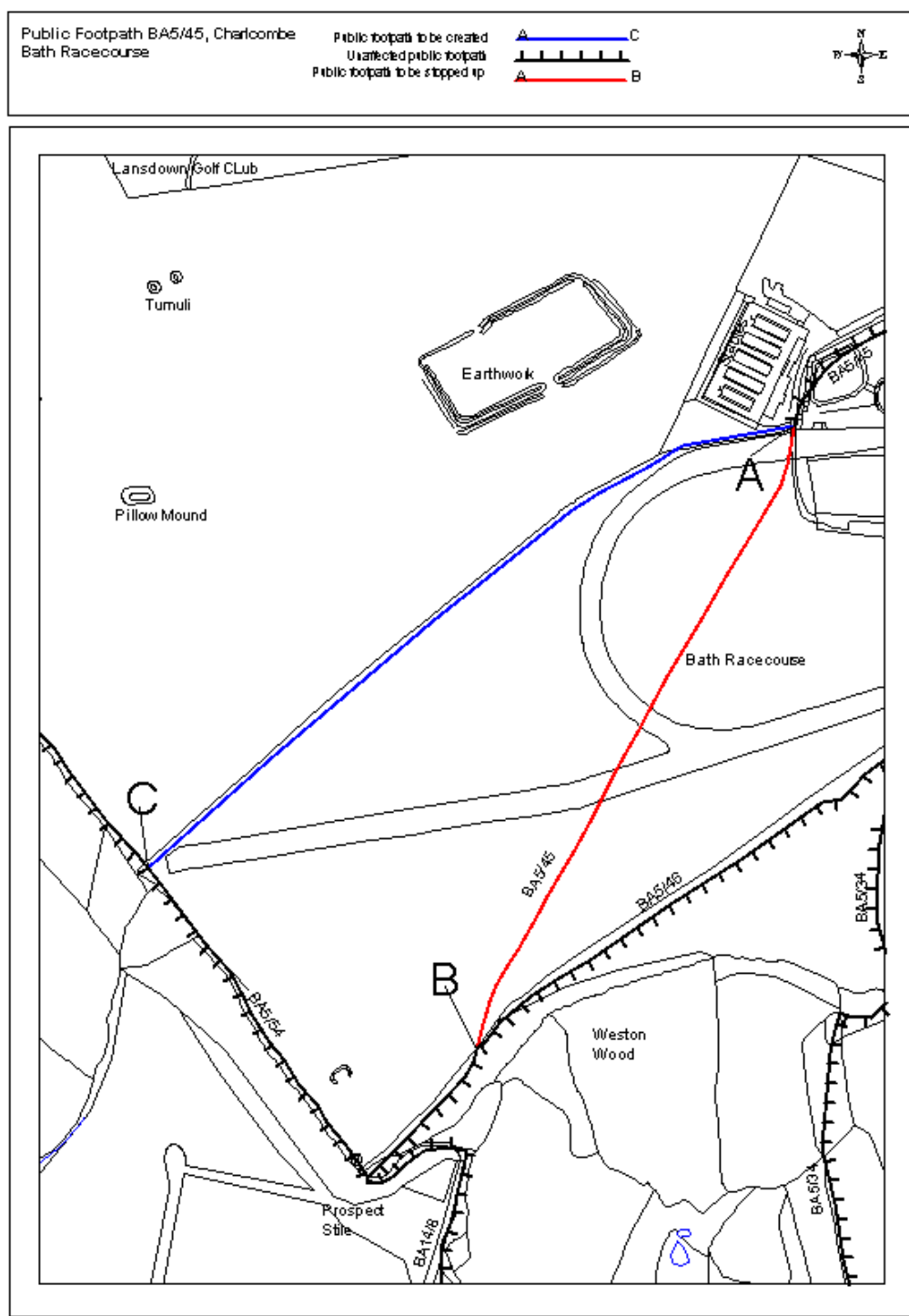
**FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS**

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of public footpaths BA5/35, BA5/45 and BA5/46 at Bath Racecourse in the Parish of Charlcombe

Bath and North East Somerset Council are consulting on a proposal to divert sections of Public Footpaths BA5/35, BA5/45 and BA5/46 at Bath Racecourse, Lansdown. The general effect of the proposal is shown on the attached plans. The routes to be stopped up are shown as solid red lines and the proposed routes are shown as solid blue lines.

1. BA5/46 commencing from point D (on plan A) and proceeding to point E would be stopped up. The new line would run from point E via points N, M to point L.
2. BA5/35 commencing from point F (on plan A) and proceeding to point G would be stopped up. The new line would run from point H via points L, J, K to point G.
3. A new section of footpath would be created from point K (on plan A) proceeding to a junction with Lansdown Road at point P.
4. BA5/45 commencing from point A (on plan B) and proceeding to point B would be stopped up. The new line would run from Point A to point C.

The changes are proposed in the interests of the landowner as the current routes cross Bath Racecourse.

The proposed routes would provide better connectivity from west-east/east-west, with public footpaths BA5/57, BA5/15 and BA5/18, improve safety when crossing Lansdown Lane at point H on plan A and provide views across the River Severn between points A and C on plan B.

The changes would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (the Act) and a dedication agreement. It is proposed to authorise kissing gates under s147 of the Act at point H and point P to prevent the ingress and egress of animals.
