

## NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

#### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL

#### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA15/27 AND BA15/35, HUNSTRETE, MARKSBURY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

The above order, made on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2019, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert:

1. the public footpath running from a junction with Hunstrete Lane and Public Footpath BA15/35 at grid reference ST 6478 6235 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 142 metres to grid reference ST 6477 6221 (point B) and turning in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 32 metres to grid reference ST 6479 6218 (point C) to a new line running from a junction with Hunstrete Lane at grid reference ST 6478 6234 (point D) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 27 metres to a junction with the new line of Public Footpath BA15/27 at grid reference ST 6476 6234 (point G) and continuing in a generally west-southwesterly direction for approximately 153 metres to grid reference ST 6462 6228 (point F); and
2. the public footpath running from a junction with Hunstrete Lane and Public Footpath BA15/27 at grid reference ST 6478 6235 (point A) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 91 metres to grid reference ST 6469 6233 (point E) and turning in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 91 metres to grid reference ST 6462 6228 (point F) to a new line running from a junction with the new line of Public Footpath BA15/35 at grid reference ST 6476 6234 (point G) and proceeding in a generally south-southeasterly direction for approximately 100 metres to grid reference ST 6480 6225 (point H) and continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 72 metres to grid reference ST 6479 6218 (point C);

as shown on the order map.

Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it will become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food

& Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
