

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257
AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL24/107,
COBBLERS WAY, WESTFIELD) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2017**

On 16th November 2017, Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order. The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that section of the public footpath CL24/107 running from a field boundary at grid reference ST 6768 5377 and continuing in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 68 metres to grid reference ST 6763 5381 and turning in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 81 metres to grid reference ST 6769 5386 and turning in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 66 metres to a field boundary at grid reference ST 6766 5390 and continuing in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 7 metres to grid reference ST 6765 5391 to a line running from a field boundary at grid reference ST 6768 5377 and continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 36 metres to grid reference ST 6767 5380 and turning in a generally easterly direction for approximately 15 metres to grid reference ST 6768 5381 and turning in a generally northerly direction for approximately 114 metres to grid reference ST 6765 5391 as shown on the order map.

The order comes into force on the date on which Bath and North East Somerset Council certify that the terms of Article 3 of the order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
