Public Path Creation Order 2017**

The above order made on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2017 under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980, will create a public footpath running from a junction with Giffords Lane at grid reference ST 6528 6753 and proceeding in a generally east north-easterly direction for approximately 52 metres to a junction with St Clements Road at grid reference ST 6533 6754 as shown on the order map.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to the Public Rights of Way Team, Bath and North East Somerset Council, Lewis House, Manvers Street, Bath, BA1 1JG not later than **15<sup>th</sup> January 2018**. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received will be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it will become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Bath and North East Somerset Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
