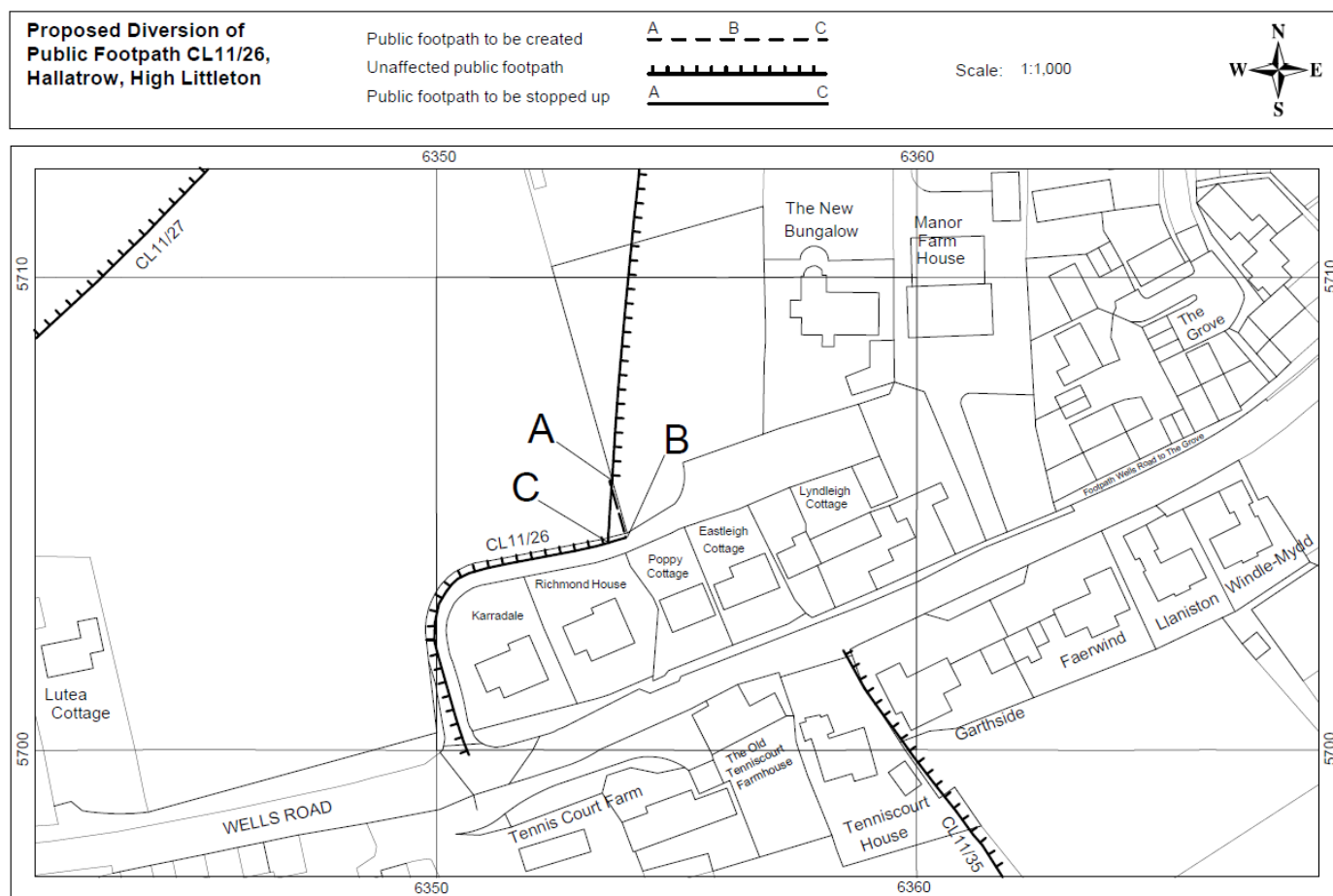


FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL PUBLIC FOOTPATH USERS

B&NES Council are proposing to change the Public Rights of Way network in respect of Public Footpath ("FP") CL11/26 in Hallatrow

The general effect of the proposal is shown on the above plan.

The section of the FP commencing from grid reference ST 6353 5705 (point A on the plan) continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 13 metres to grid reference ST 6353 5704 at point C would be stopped up, as shown on the plan by a continuous black line. The new line of the FP CL11/26 would commence from the same point, and proceed in a generally south-southeasterly direction for approximately 12 metres to grid reference ST 6353 5704 and then in a generally westerly direction for approximately 4 metres to point C, as shown on the plan by a dashed black line.

These changes are proposed to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission 19/00035/RES and would be achieved by way of a diversion order made under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The new footpath will be 2 metres in width. The existing stile at point A will be replaced with a kissing gate. Works will be carried out through the development process to bring the new paths to a condition fit for public use.
