On 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019, Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 26 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to create a public bridleway running from a junction with Newlands Road at grid reference ST 6486 6751 (Point A) and proceeding in a generally south-southeasterly direction for approximately 51 metres to grid reference ST 6487 6746 (Point B) and turning in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 17 metres to grid reference ST 6487 6745 (Point C) and turning in a generally south-southeasterly direction for approximately 87 metres to grid reference ST 6491 6738 (Point D) and turning in a generally south-southwesterly direction for approximately 10 metres to a junction with Greenfield Road at grid reference ST 6490 6737 (Point E) as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at The One Stop Shop at Market Walk, Keynsham during normal office hours. The order comes into force on 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
