

NOTICE OF ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA12/12, THE TYNING, FRESHFORD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") has made an order, the effect of which will be to continue the temporary closure of the section of public footpath BA12/12 commencing from a junction with public footpaths BA12/11 and BA12/9 at grid reference ST 7886 5997 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 430 metres to a junction with Rosemary Lane at grid reference ST 7869 5967 (Point B on the Notice Plan). The temporary closure commenced on 30th November 2023 by notice under section 14(2) of the 1984 Act.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely, the danger caused by the eroded surface of the footpath which requires repair before it can once again be used safely. The Order will come into force on 21st December 2023 and will be effective for six months. (However the footpath will be re-opened sooner if the planned repair works are completed sooner).
