

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BC56/31, KENSINGTON GARDENS, BATH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to the section of Public Footpath BC56/31 commencing from Kensington Gardens at grid reference ST 7561 6609 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 28 metres to a junction with Hanover Street at grid reference ST 7561 6606 (point B on the Notice Plan).




This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the rights of way; namely the applicant will be carrying out repairs to her garden wall which borders the public footpath. The Order will come into force on 4th September 2023 and will be effective for **four weeks**.
