

## EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE

### SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect on public footpath BA27/87 commencing from a junction with Dryleaze at grid reference ST 6531 6915 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally northwesterly direction for approximately 865 metres to a junction with Durley Lane grid reference ST 6471 6964 (Point C on the Notice Plan).

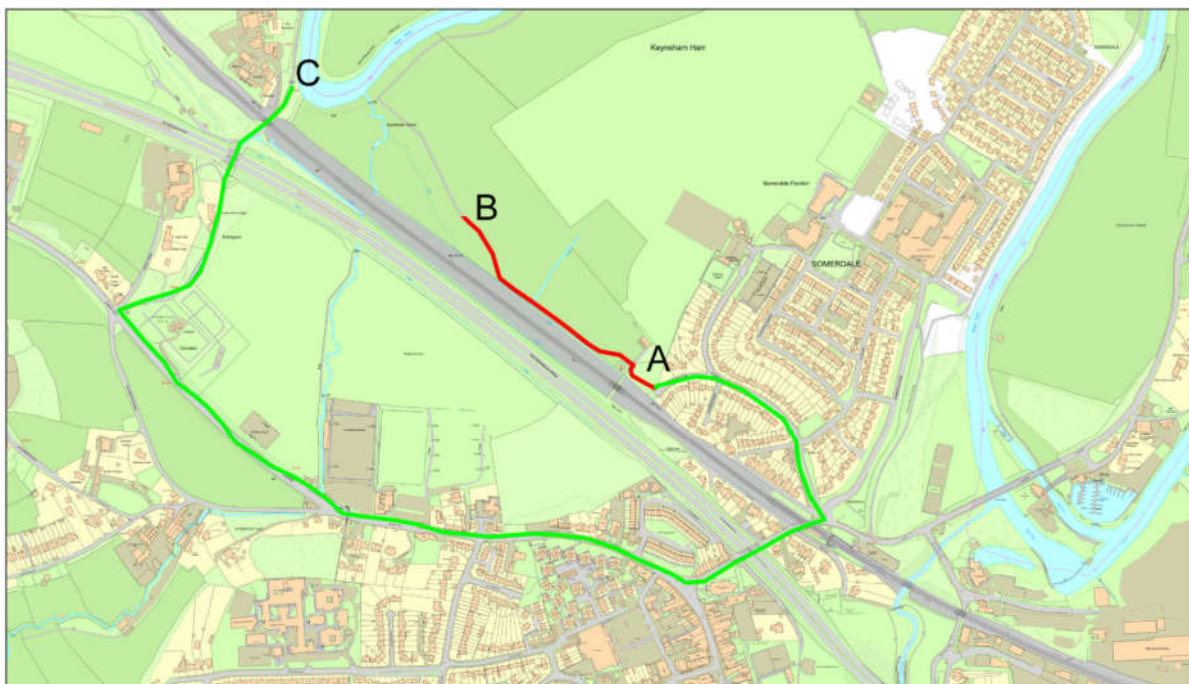
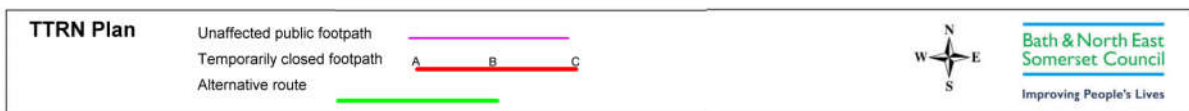
This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road; namely, a missing bridge over drainage ditch. The closure has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for 21 days.
