(PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL24/18, WELLOW BROOK WALK, MIDSOMER NORTON)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL24/18, Wellow Brook Walk, Midsomer Norton in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic over the said footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the rights of way; namely, Western Power Distribution are proposing to carry out high voltage cable excavation and laying works.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed over the full length of Public Footpath CL24/18 commencing from a junction with Northmead Road at grid reference ST 6576 5477 (point A on the order map) and continuing in a generally easterly direction for approximately 600 metres to a junction with Public Footpath CL24/24 at grid reference ST 6635 5472 (point B on the order map).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 23rd May 2022 and will be operative for a period of 16 weeks. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath CL24/18, Wellow Brook Walk, Midsomer Norton) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2022.
