## **SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA2/5, RIVERPATH, BATHEASTON) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Notice is given that the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has extended an order the effect of which will temporarily introduce a path closure to the section of public footpath BA2/5 commencing from a junction with public footpaths BA2/3 and BA2/4 at ST 7747 6706 (Point A) and proceeding in a generally north easterly direction along the riverpath for approximately 610 metres to grid reference ST 7795 6738 (Point B).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road; namely, the riverbank has been undermined by river erosion. The Order was extended on14th June 2024 for up to twelve months.
