(PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL3/29, MOORLEDGE LANE, CHEW MAGNA)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL3/29 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely a newly-formed watercourse, of a sufficient depth and width to cause such a danger, particularly after heavy rain.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath CL3/29 commencing from the junction with Public Byway CL3/23 and Public Footpath CL3/31 at grid reference ST 5857 6268 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 527 metres to the junction with Moorledge Lane at grid reference ST 5861 6219 (Point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 6 November 2024 and will be operative for a period of six months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset (Public Footpath CL3/29, Moorledge Lane, Chew Magna) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024.
