Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to temporarily introduce a path closure to Public Footpath CL3/29 commencing from the junction with Public Byway CL3/23 and Public Footpath CL3/31 at grid reference ST 5857 6268 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 527 metres to the junction with Moorledge Lane at grid reference ST 5861 6219 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely a newly-formed watercourse, of a sufficient depth and width to cause such a danger, particularly after heavy rain. The Order will come into force on 6 November 2024 (continuing the emergency 21-day closure put in place on 16 October 2024) and will be effective for six months.
