

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER
SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984
BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL
(BC/RIV1, RIVERPATH, BATH)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order to the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a path closure to the section of Public Footpath BC/RIV1 commencing from Riverbank at grid reference ST 7484 6441 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding generally in an east-southeasterly direction for approximately 35 metres to the junction with Broad Quay at grid reference ST 7493 6438 (point B on the Notice Plan).

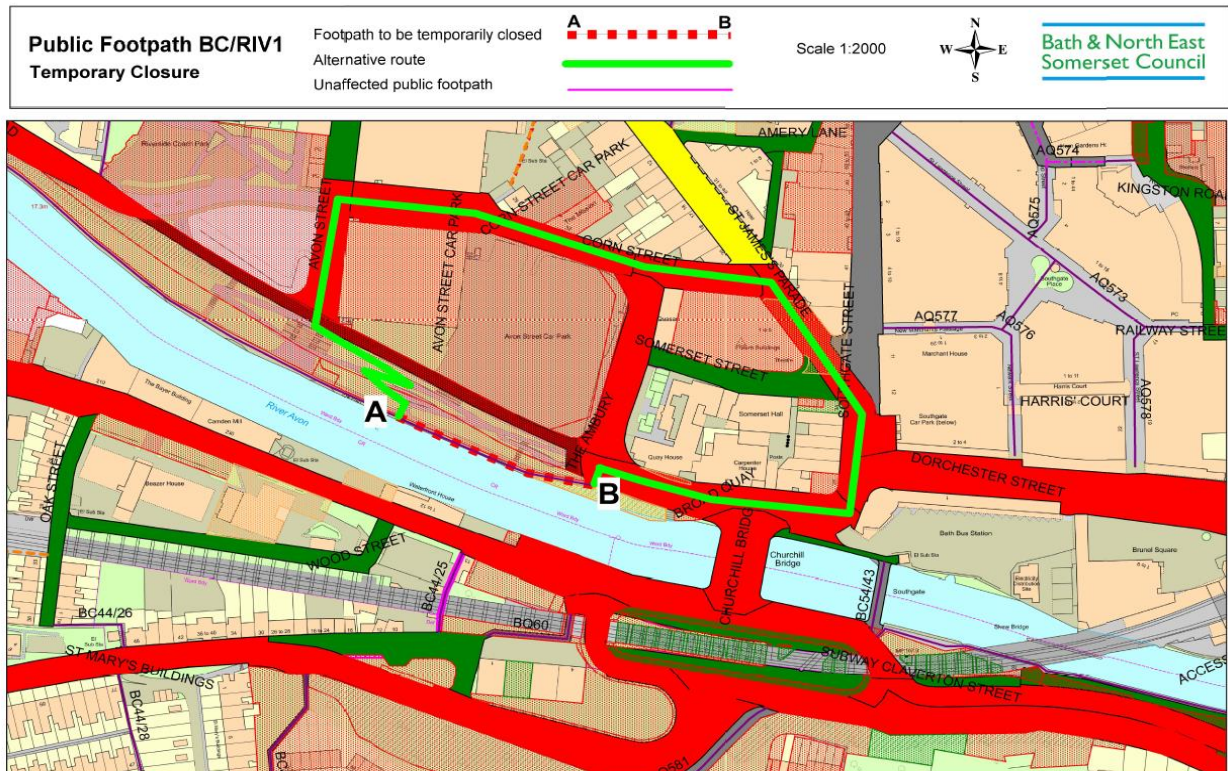
This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Wessex Water are constructing a sewer. The Order will come into force on 26 July 2021 and will be effective for 6 weeks.
