Consultation Adoption of Bath & North East Somerset Placemaking Plan .

It would appear from the information provided to date that little regard has been paid to comment on policies made over the years, respondents have covered many major issues including the Inspectors deliberations, such as Green Belts Removal justification in the context of the Green belt Review stage 1cd9/E2 and stage 2 CD 9/E9 report in principle. Proposed change CSA44 and safeguarded land given the close relationship of Bristol and having regard to NPPF.

There would be an abnormal amount of harm to heritage assets, landscape and ecology of the area to be allocated and so causing significant amount of harm, the requirement to consider whether this Placemaker Plan fully offers sustainability in its development, in both housing and road alterations.

I would conclude with my objection, and trust the adoption of this plan is not made on the basis of a political solution but on an environmental one.
