

## NOTICE OF MAKING AN ARTICLE FOUR DIRECTION

### Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (as amended)

#### Notice of making of Direction under article 4(1) of General Permitted Development Order 1995 (as amended)

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL GIVES NOTICE that the Council has made a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (as amended) in respect of all land in the City of Bath.

The Article 4 Direction applies to the whole of the City of Bath area and will come into effect, subject to confirmation, on 1 July 2013.

The effect of the Direction once it is in force is that development of the descriptions set out below should not be carried out unless permission is granted by Bath and North East Somerset Council on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

The development to which this Direction relates comprises:

Development consisting of a change of the use of a building to a use falling within Class C4 (houses of multiple occupation) of the Schedule to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) from a use falling within Class C3 (dwelling houses) of that Schedule being development comprised within Class I(b) of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Town And Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 (as amended) and not being development comprised within any other Class.

A copy of the Direction and plan defining the area to which it relates may be inspected at The Bath One Stop Shop, 3 - 4 Manvers Street, Bath, BA1 1JQ between the hours of 0830 and 1700 Monday to Thursday and 0830 and 1630 Friday from 31 May 2012 until 20 July 2012 being a period of at least 21 days from 31 May 2012 the date on which the Direction was made.

Any representations or objections concerning the Direction must be made to the Planning Policy Team, Bath and North East Somerset Council, P.O Box 5006, Bath BA1 1JG and received by 1630 on Friday 20 July 2012 stating the grounds upon which they are made.

**The Direction will come into effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013.**
