A background to the project

The project was developed by ragdoll to run both online and offline in the forms of a web based survey and a paper version of the survey.

All residents in the parish received a paper copy of the survey which informed them of the option to fill out the survey online.

The delivery of the surveys commenced on the 23rd of February and ran throughout March into April.

The closing date of fieldwork was the 13th of April.

All online and offline data was combined and the following slides outline the findings as a whole.

Please note that the base varies from question to question as some respondents have chosen not to provide a response to certain questions. Where there are multiple charts on one slide we show the bases from left to right (for example 234 / 20)

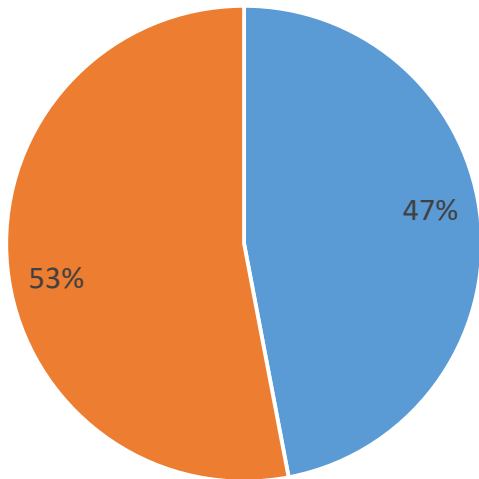

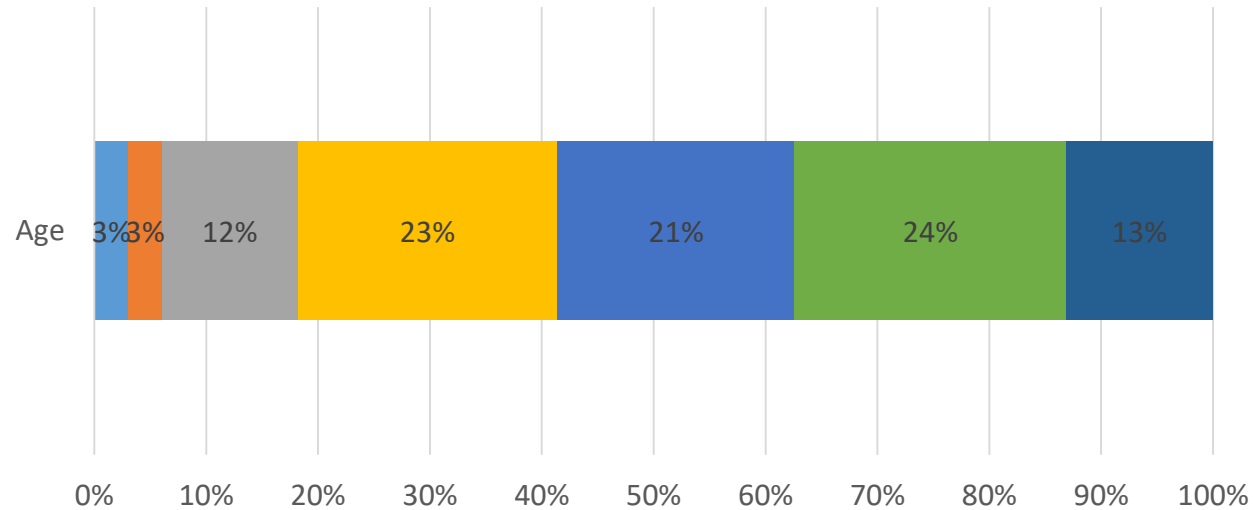

Male Female

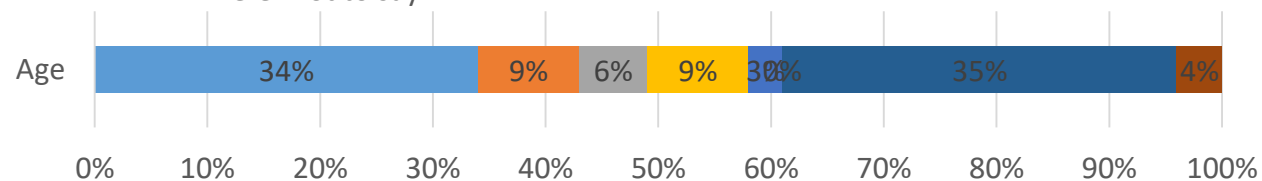


18-24 25-34 35-44 45-54 55-64 65-74 75+



A balanced spread of gender, while 60% of the sample were 55+ and the largest proportion were retired.

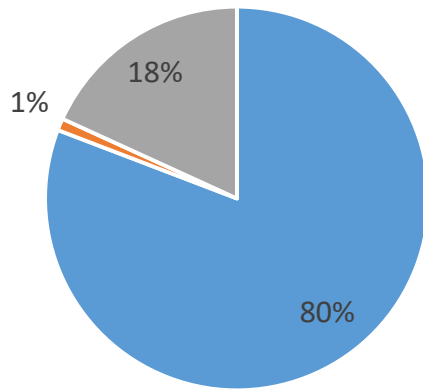

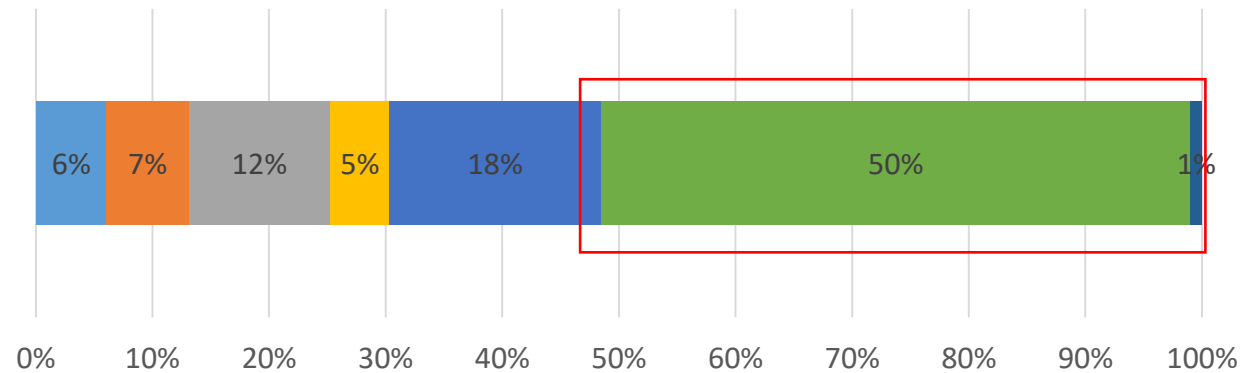

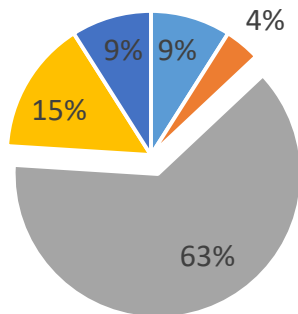

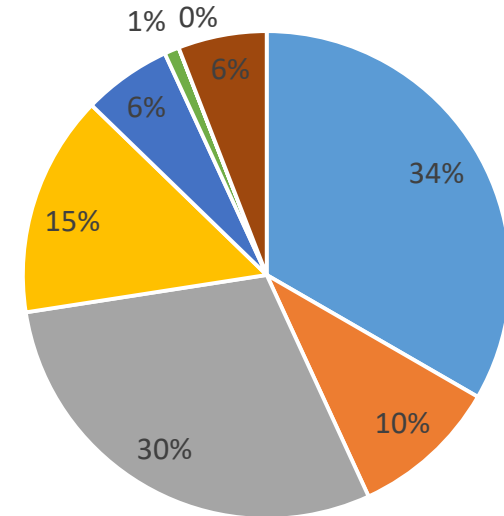

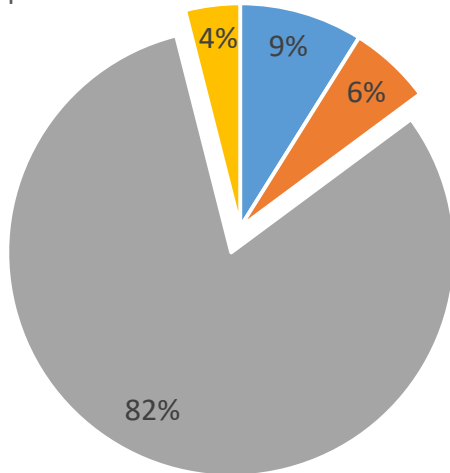

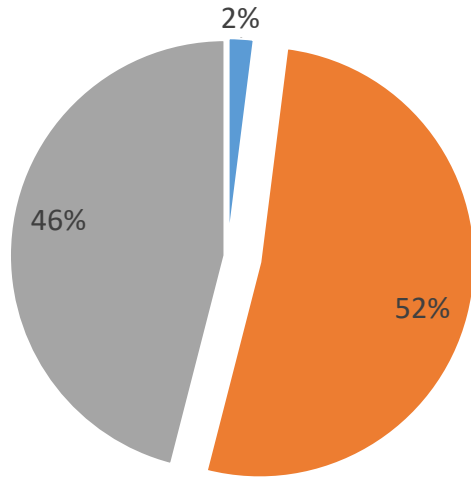
What number bus do you use?



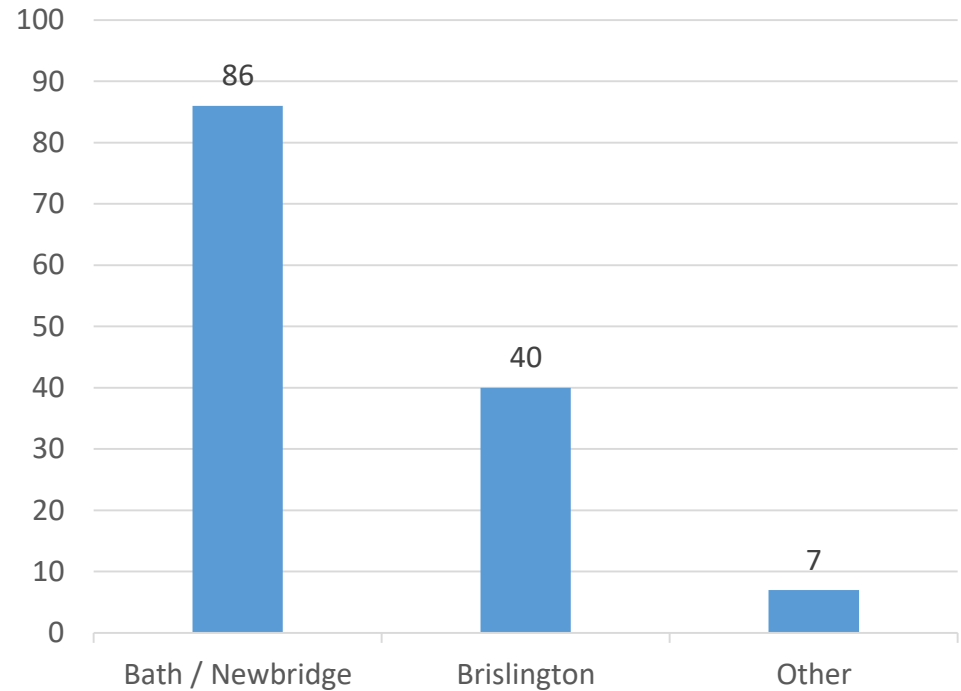

Where do you mainly travel to?

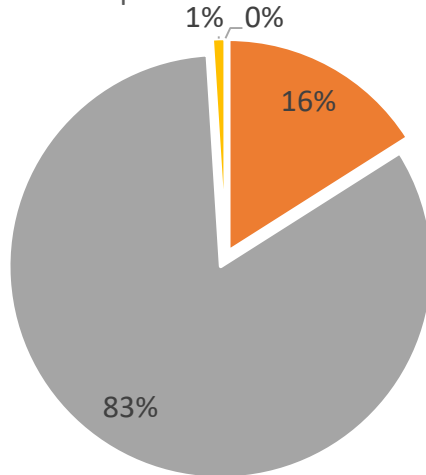

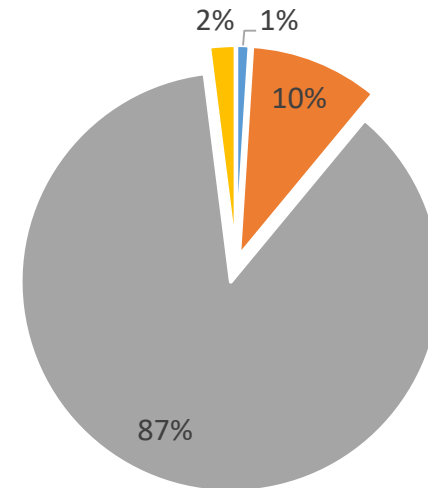

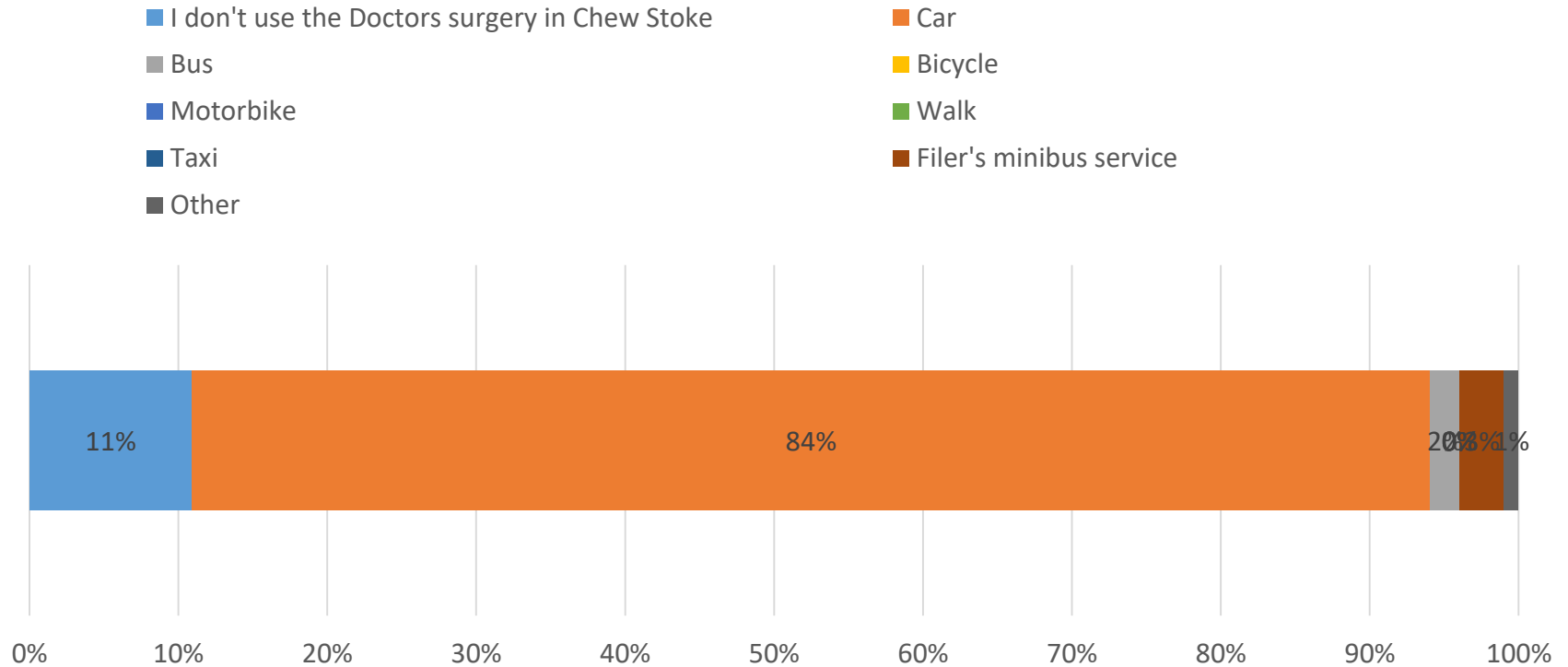
Do you walk to

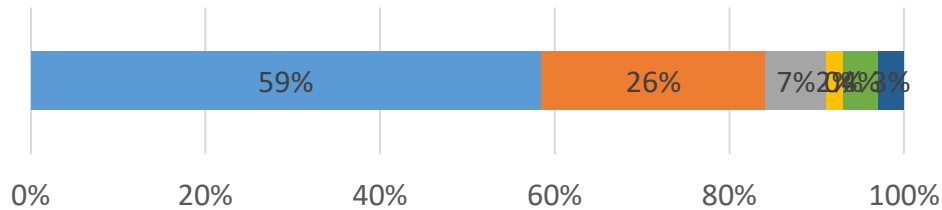
How do you mostly travel to the doctors surgery in Chew Stoke?

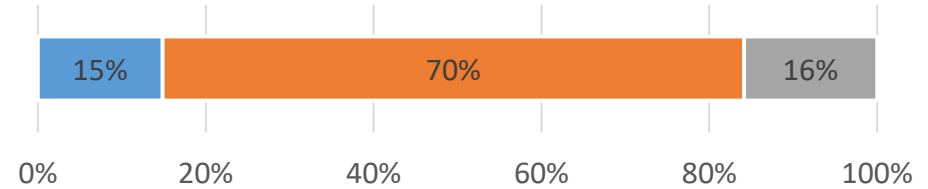
In terms of village public transport, what does regular mean to you?

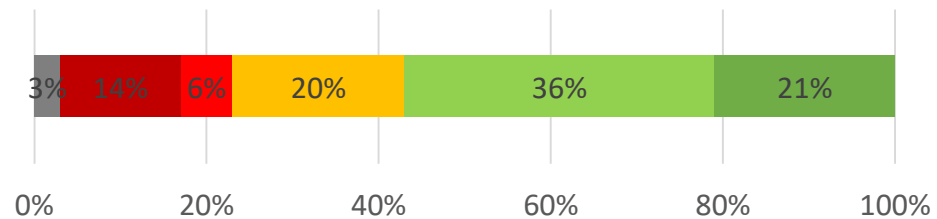

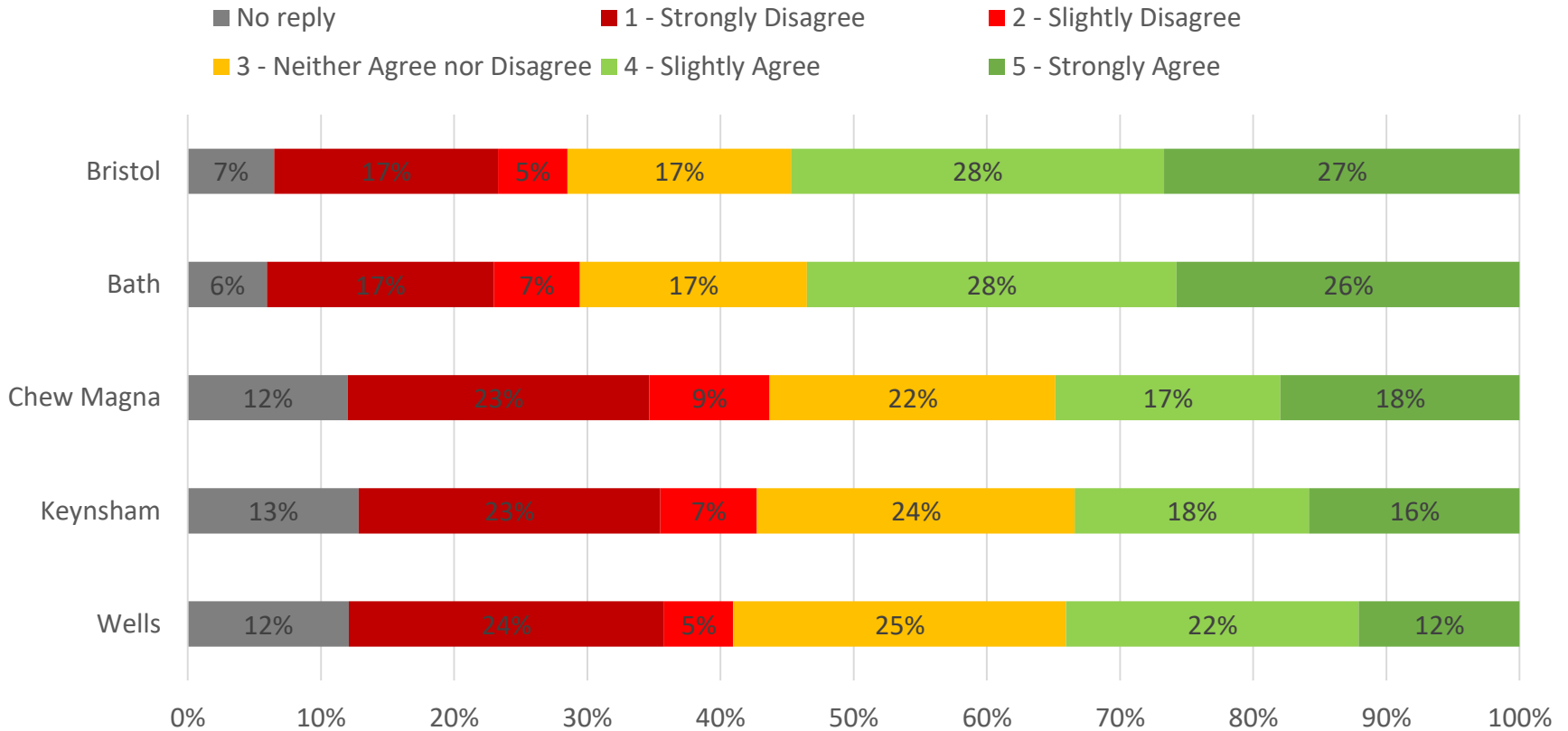

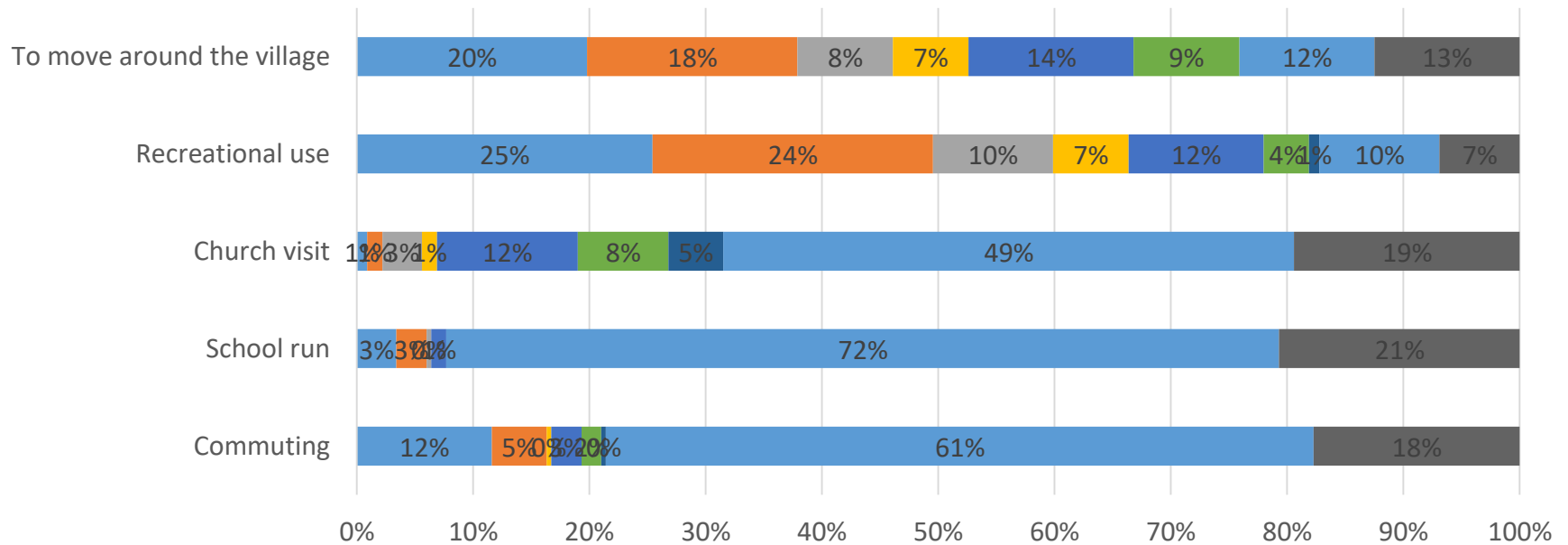
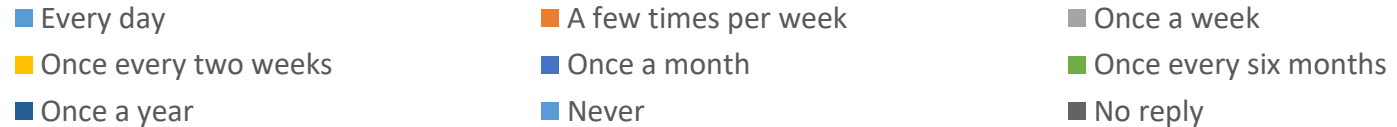
Optional regular location usage

I would use a regular bus service to / from the following destination if it were available...

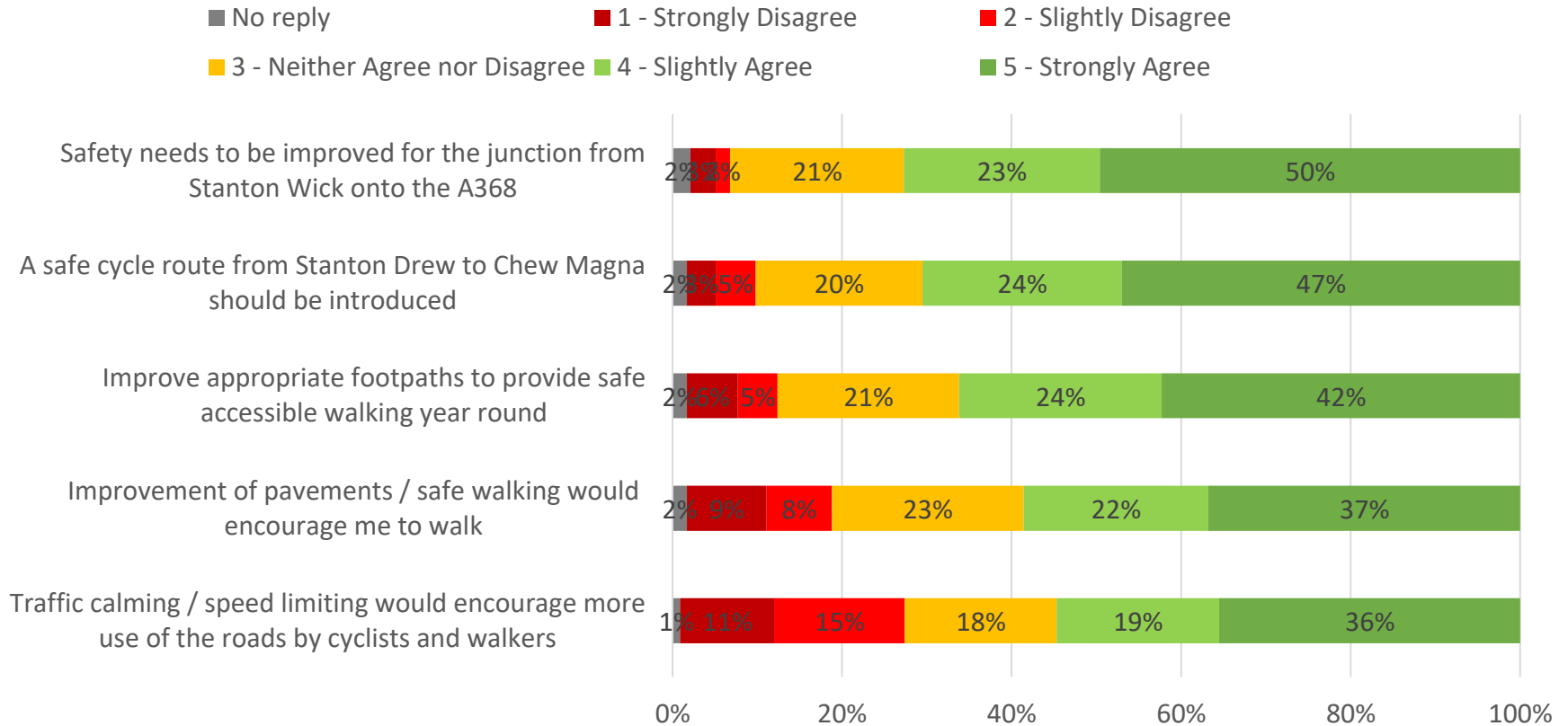


Countryside, footpaths and public rights of way

How often do you use the local footpaths, bridleways or lanes for the following activities/ excursions?

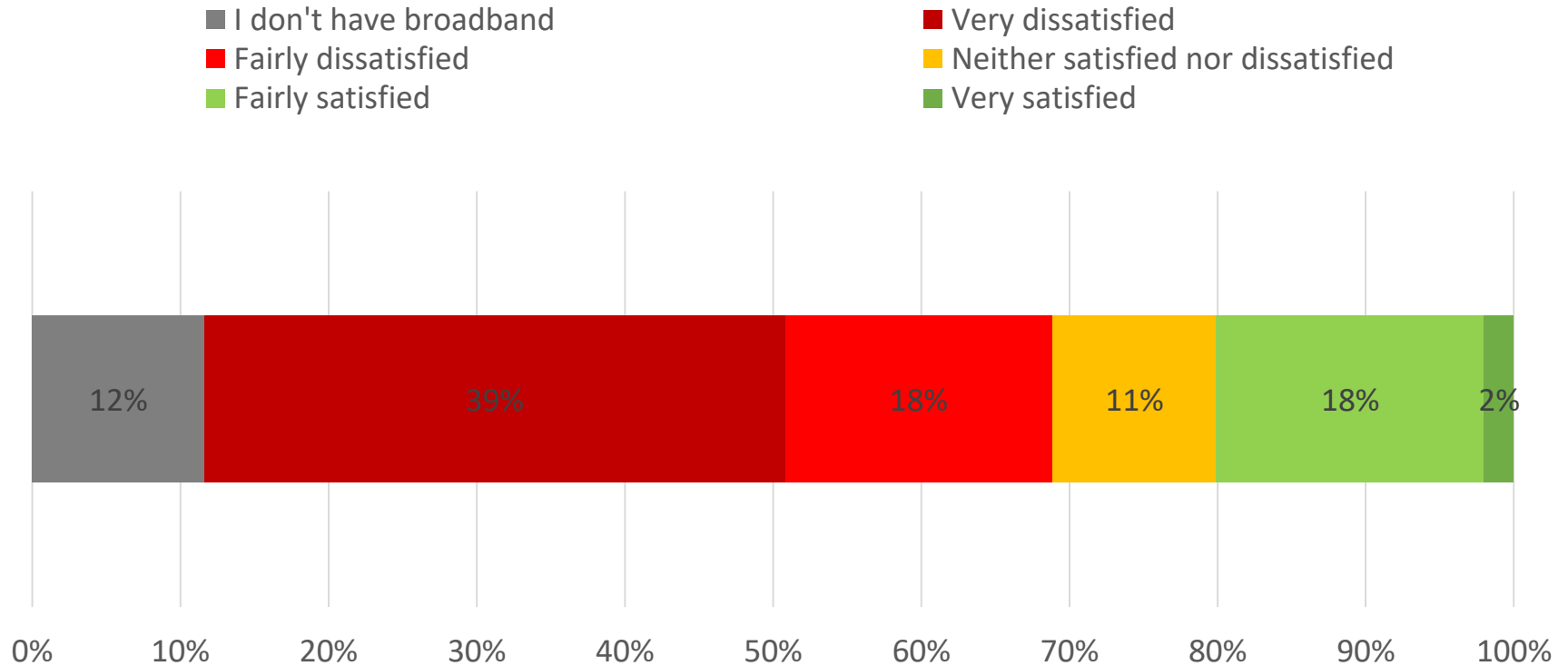

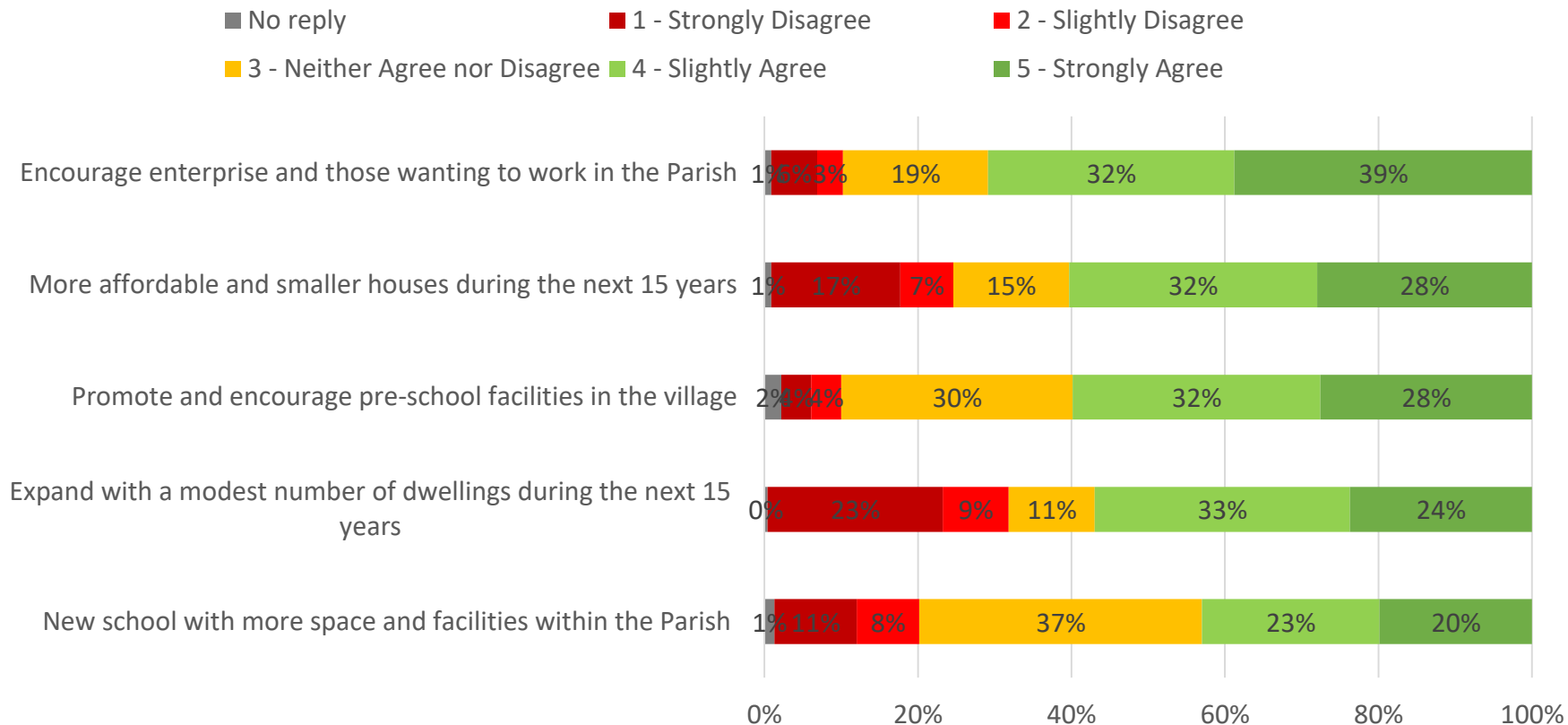
Broadband satisfaction

To what extent are you satisfied / dissatisfied with you home broadband service?

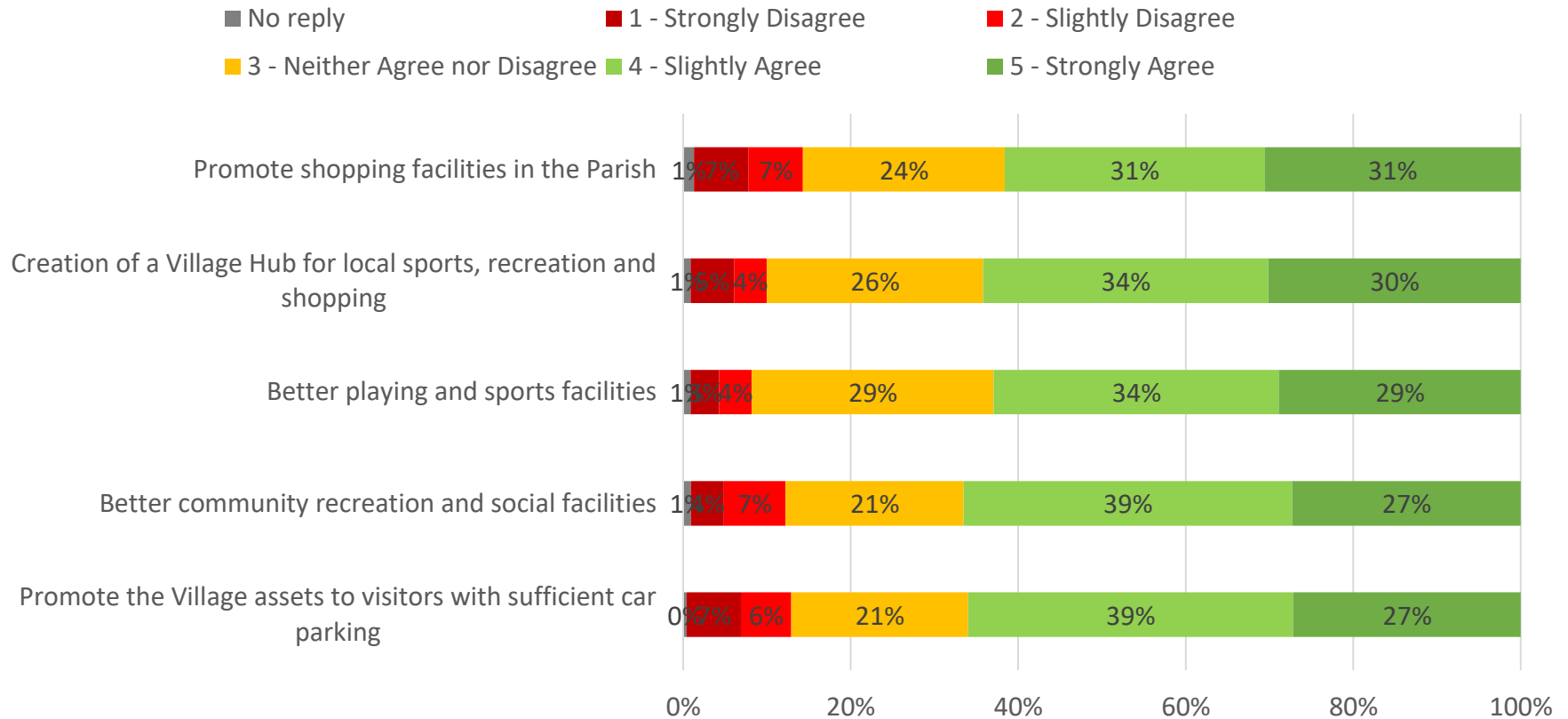

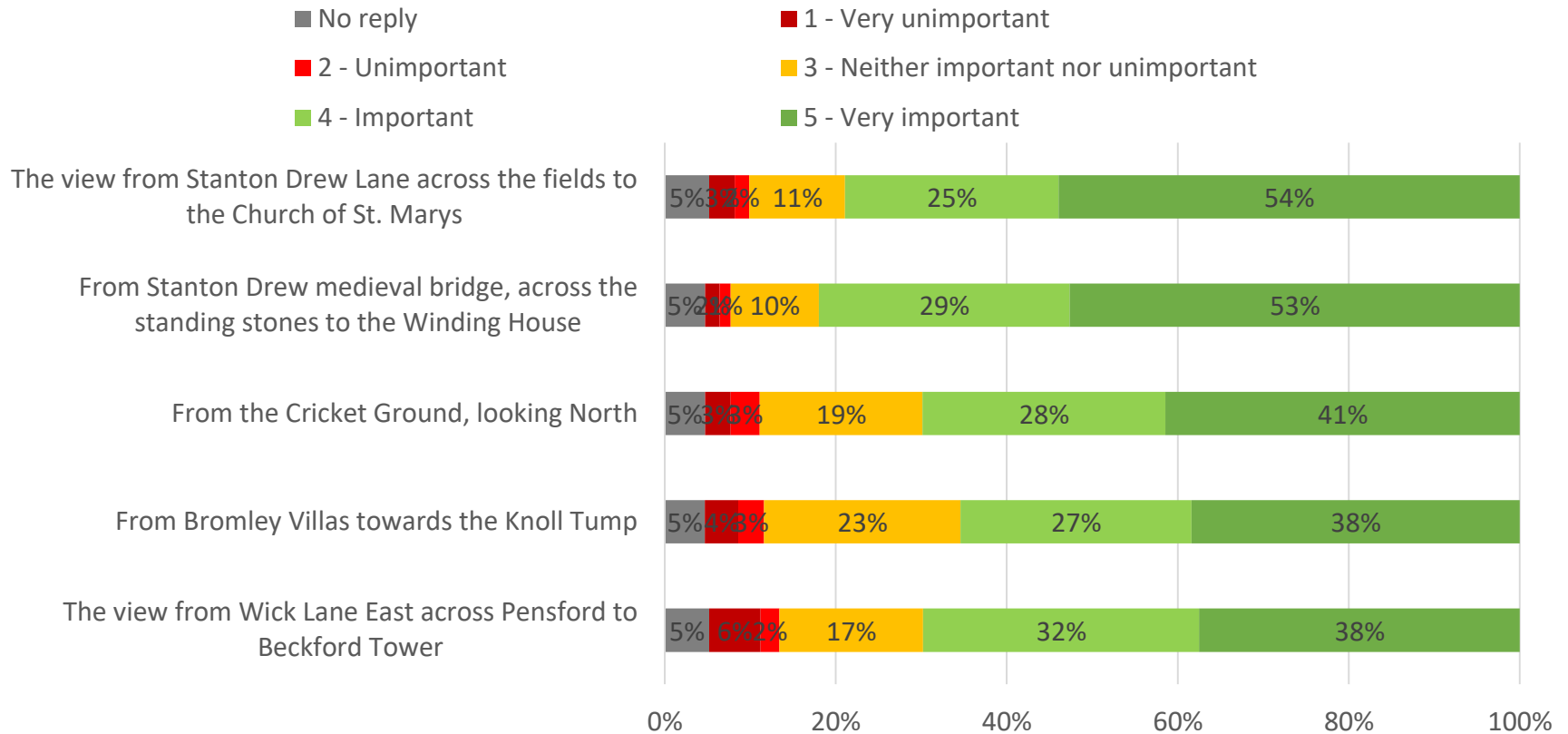

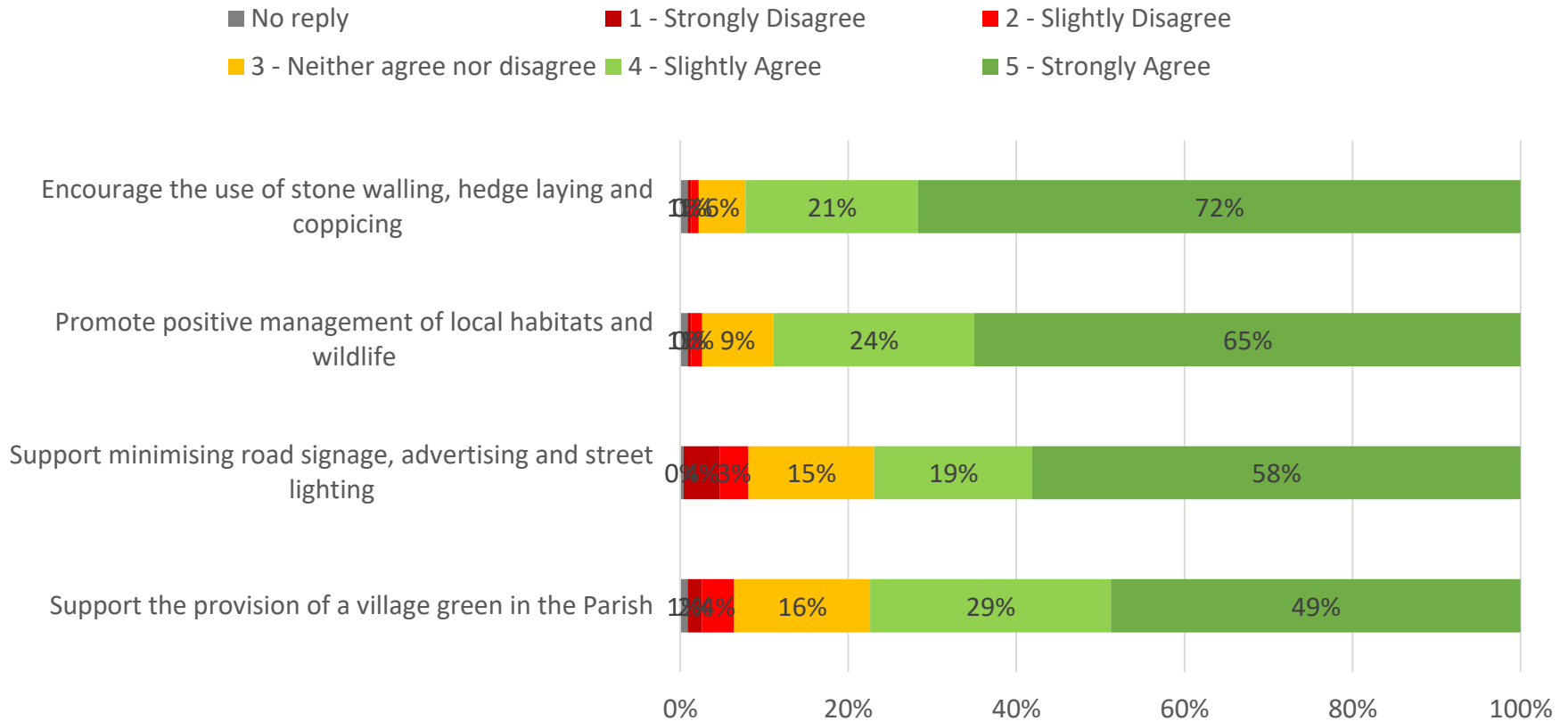

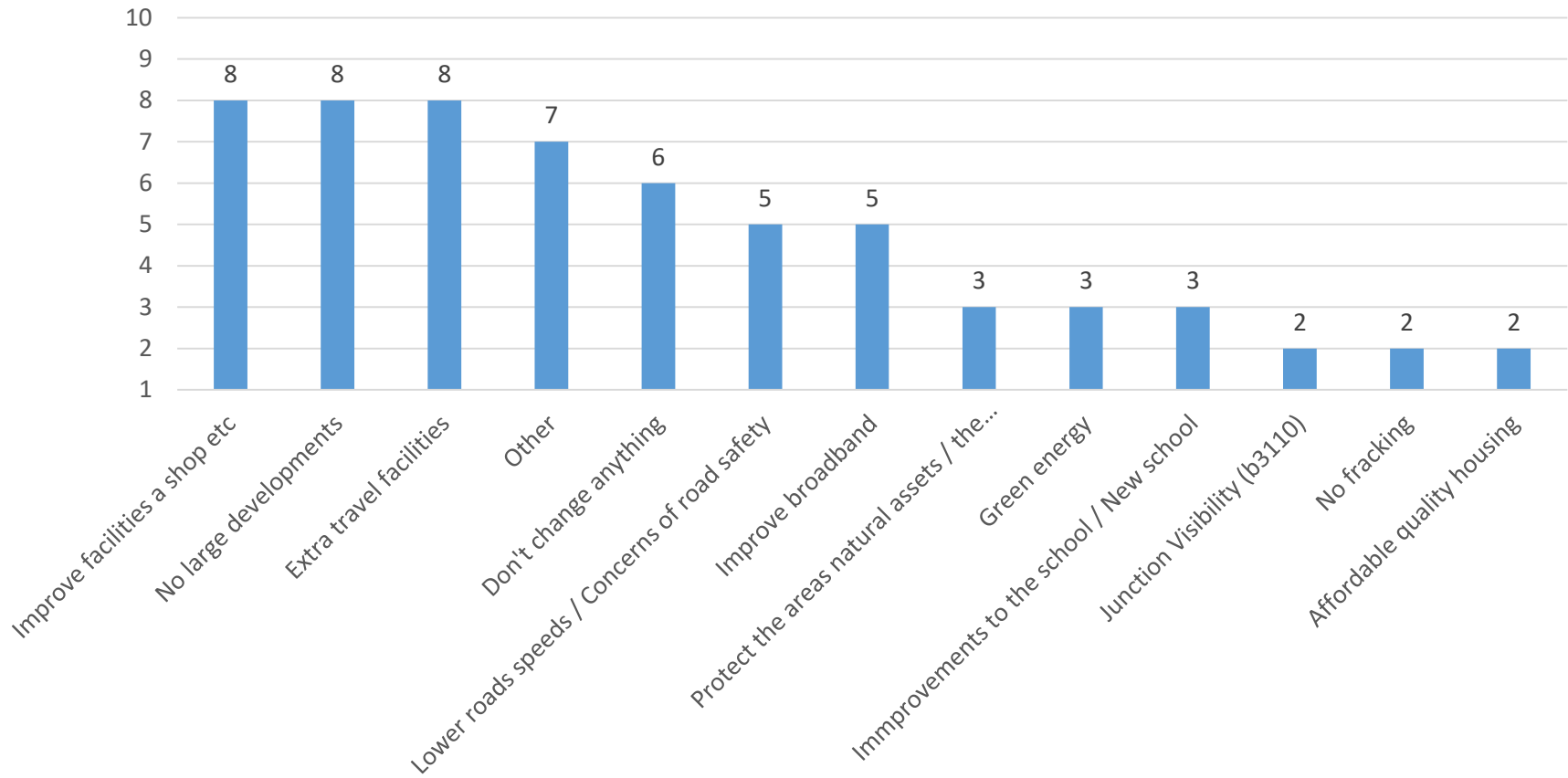
