Adoption of the Sustainable Construction & Retrofitting Supplementary Planning Document

I am writing to inform you that the above Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) has been adopted on 21st March 2013. It will now form part of Bath & North East Somerset's Local Development Framework. The Supplementary Planning Document is a user-friendly 'how to' guide to Sustainable Construction & Retrofitting. It includes:

- 9 Sustainable construction principles to help you green any new build project
- Explanation of how the 5 main house types in the area are built
- Introduces 24 retrofit options from energy and water efficiency to heating and domestic renewable energy
- What planning, building control & listed building permissions you may need

This SPD supplements saved the Bath and North East Somerset Council Local Plan and Policies CP1 and CP2 of the Core Strategy once it is adopted.

Adoption Statement March 2013

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 that Bath and North East Somerset Council adopted the above-mentioned Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 13th February 2013.

The Sustainable Construction & Retrofitting Supplementary Planning Document provides guidance in support of policies in the Local Plan and Core Strategy (CP1 & 2) in relation to building sustainably and incorporating energy efficiency or domestic scale renewable energy.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after 21st March 2013.
