TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1973

WHEREAS the Wansdyke District Council being the District Planning Authority for the administrative District of Wansdyke in the County of Avon (hereinafter called "the Council") are satisfied that the development set out in the Schedule hereto on the lend at Keynsham shown edged in red on the plan annexed hereto (hereinafter called "the said land") would constitute arthreat to the amenities of the area and should not be undertaken unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning Act 1971

NOW THEREFORE:

the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 (hereinafter called "the said Order") hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

SCHEDULE

The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture being development comprised within Class VI referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other class.
