# Stanton Drew – Neighbourhood Plan Survey April 2015



The project was developed by ragdoll to run both online and offline in the forms of a web based survey and a paper version of the survey.

All residents in the parish received a paper copy of the survey which informed them of the option to fill out the survey online.

The delivery of the surveys commenced on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of February and ran throughout March into April.

The closing date of fieldwork was the 13<sup>th</sup> of April.






### The demographics of those who took part







### Getting to the Chew Stoke doctors surgery




