**INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR MULBERRY PARK EDUCATE TOGETHER
PRIMARY SCHOOL**

PLACES AVAILABLE: 30

As Mulberry Park Educate Together Primary School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2022/23', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

A total of **72 preferences** were originally received for Mulberry Park Educate Together Primary School which has an Admission Number of **30**.

If, under any of the categories listed, places were offered and refused, priority was given to those who live closest to the school as measured in a direct line between the home address and the school.

How the initial allocation of places was made for this school:

0 places have been offered to a child with an Education, Health and Care Plan where the school has been named in their statement.

0 Category 1 Applicants - Looked after children or previously looked after children

8 Category 2 Applicants – Children who have a sibling attending the school at the time the application is received. Where an older sibling is in year 6 at the time of application the sibling will not be prioritised.

22 Category 3 Applicants – Other Children. **The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 1.061 miles.**

4 children have initially been refused a place at Mulberry Park Educate Together Primary School. (All other preferences originally considered have qualified for another school as a higher preference)

CLASS SIZE PREJUDICE APPEALS – Effects of Infant Class Size Legislation:

Appeals for Mulberry Park Educate Together Primary School will be heard on the basis of Infant Class Size Prejudice as the school will organise with one Reception class containing 30 pupils with one full-time qualified teacher (or the equivalent of).

1 Child in Category 3. **The furthest distance offered within this category was 1.209 miles.**
