Candidates' spending limit by ward

The spending limit for the regulated period is £806 plus 7p per local government elector in the ward registered on 1 March 2023.

The spending limit is reduced by 25% for joint candidates.

The regulated period begins on the day after the date a person officially becomes a candidate and ends on Thursday 4 May 2023.

Candidates and their agents must follow the Electoral Commission's guidance on spending and donations.
