INITIAL ALLOCATION STATEMENT FOR BATHWICK ST MARY CHURCH SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 30

As Bathwick St. Mary Church School was oversubscribed it was necessary to use the Academy Trust's admissions criteria, as published in 'A Primary School for Your Child – 2024/25', to allocate the places available at the school. Applications for all schools are considered under an equal preference system which means that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school are considered equally. If there are any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school has been allocated.

Under the scheme the number of 'on time' preferences that required places at Bathwick St Mary Church School met the school's admission number of 30.

Position as at 13th June 2024 following the second round of allocations on 29th May 2024

1 place has become available after the second round of allocations.

These children were considered for the 1 place available, and the place has been offered to:

1 Child in Category 6. Children who, at the time of application, lives within the Bathwick Parishes. **The furthest direct line distance between the preferred school and the home address offered in this category was 0.333 miles.**

1 Child has been refused a place at Bathwick St Mary Church School.
