

INFANT TO JUNIOR ADMISSIONS - SEPTEMBER 2024

ALLOCATIONS STATEMENT FOR MOORLANDS JUNIOR SCHOOL

PLACES AVAILABLE: 60

Applications for all schools which were submitted before the closing date of 15/01/2024 were considered under an equal preference system which meant that all preferences (1st, 2nd & 3rd) for each school were considered equally for places initially under the school's published admissions criteria. If there were any cases where more than one of the school preferences named on the application form could have been met only the highest preference school was allocated.

Under the scheme the number of 'on time' preferences that required places at Moorlands Junior School met the school's admission number of 60.

Position as at 29 May 2024

Following the initial allocations on 16 April 2024, 1 place has become available.

4 late applications were received.

These children were considered for the 1 available place, and it has been offered to a child under **Category B Applicant** - Children for whom there will be a sibling in attendance on the admission date at Moorlands Infant or Junior School. The furthest direct line distance being offered in this category was **0.164 miles**.

The furthest direct line distance being offered in this category was **0.781 miles.**

All children were considered for the 1 available place, and it has been offered to a child under Category C Applicants. - Children transferring from Moorlands Infant School without a sibling in attendance on the admission date at Moorlands Infant or the Junior School. The furthest direct line distance being offered in this category was **0.149 miles.**

Position as at 9 July 2024

Following the initial allocations on 16 April 2024, 2 places have become available.

All children were considered for the available places, and it has been offered to children under Category D Applicants. Children who live closest to the Junior School as measured in a direct line from the address point of the Junior school. The furthest direct line distance being offered in this category was **0.801 miles.**
