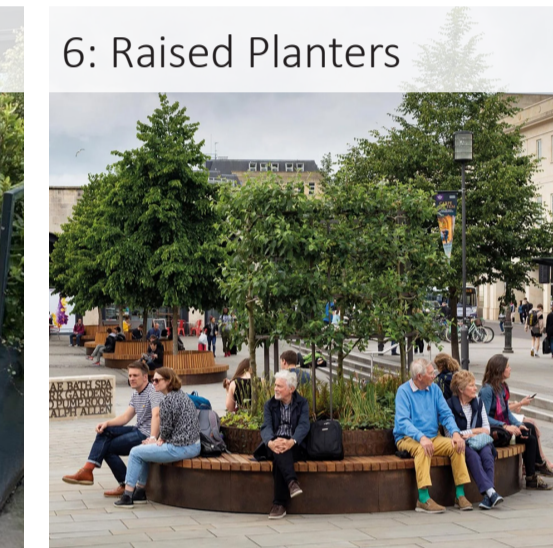
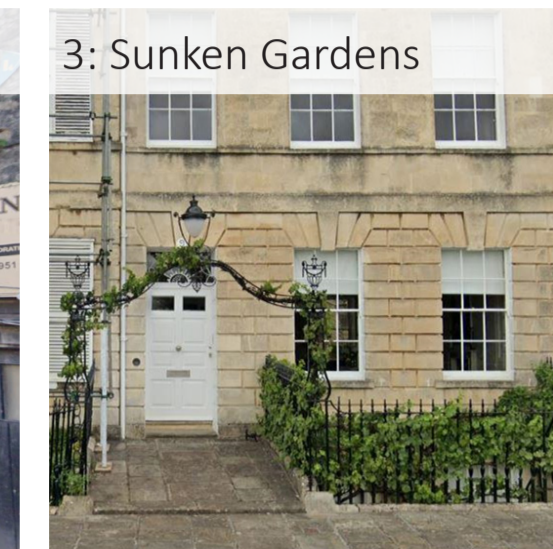
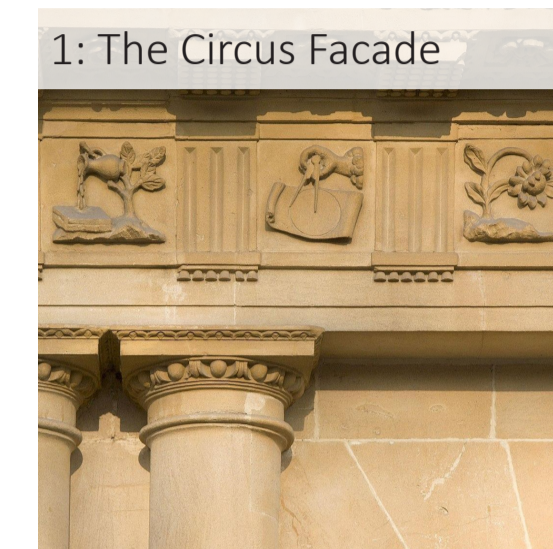

Approach to Site - Spatial Ingredients / Principles on Plan

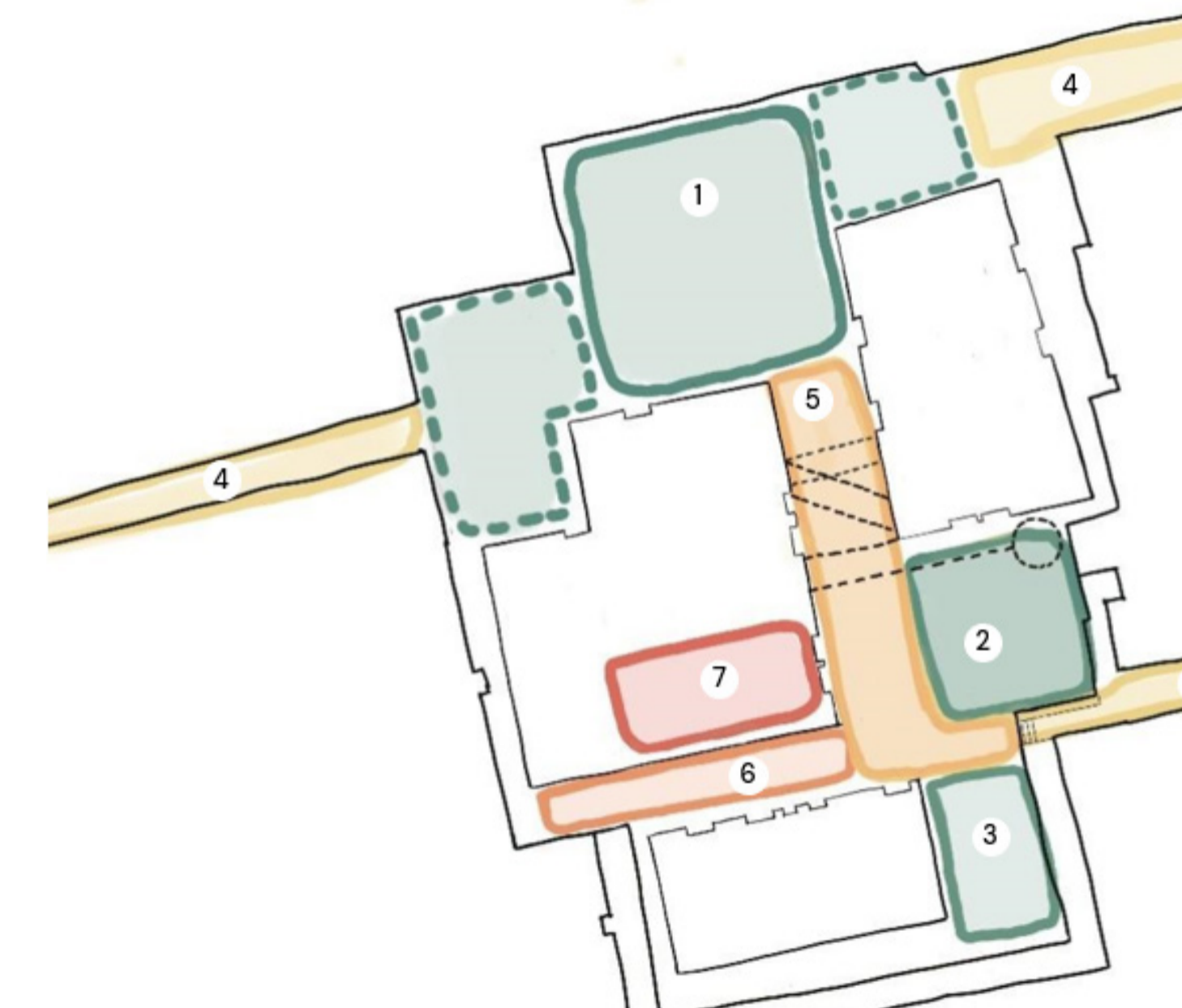


How does Bath Integrate Nature in its Urban Fabric?



- 1. The Circus Facade**
Elements of the natural world are carved in stone
- 2. Greening of Walls**
Colonised wall planting provides unexpected elements of green
- 3. Sunken Garden**
Georgian basement gardens as secret green oasis
- 4. The Working Mews**
Maker studios occupy spaces for dwelling and socialising
- 5. Parklets**
Raised planters provide screening for seating areas
- 6. Raised Planters**
Movable planter seats allowing changes for different events
