Potential for cost to continue to rise if eligible children demand continues to increase.

#### Any possible mitigating measures or actions

Mitigations cost avoidance, Travel Manager overseeing SEND eligibility. Continuing to recruit drivers to enable increase of in house provision, recruitment has proven problematic due to onboarding times. Driver can apply and start work within 1 week in private sector. B&NES minimum of 6 weeks and usually longer with the need for applicant to access computer to progress the various stages. Review of 2 main schools using Q routes no significant benefits identified which demonstrates routes selection robust. Working with SEND team to try and bring forward dates for placement as currently we are still getting these through August and into September resulting in in efficient tenders. Safety valve will deliver new schools at Charlton House and Rush Hill. The benefits still need quantifying but will improve placement information and should reduce cost for out of area.
