- 4. Introduce a dual use Bus Stand No Stopping Except Buses operating between 9am 6.30pm and Loading Only Bay operating between 6.30pm 9am in lengths of Orange Grove, Bath.
- 5. Introduce No Parking At Any Time in lengths of Orange Grove, Bath.
- 6. Introduce No Stopping On School Keep Clear Markings At Any Time in lengths of Archway Street, Bath.
- 7. Introduce a Bus Stand No Stopping Except Local Buses in lengths of Ambury and Broad Quay, Bath.
