PEDESTRIAN RAISED ZEBRA CROSSING <u>STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR</u> <u>PROPOSING THE ORDER</u>

The Council in exercise of their powers under The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 propose to introduce a pedestrian 'raised zebra' crossing on Lansdown Road, Bath (Adjacent to St. Stephen's Church).

This order is proposed so as:

This proposal is made in accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which under Section 23 enables local highway authorities to establish crossings for pedestrians on roads for which they are the traffic authority and may alter or remove any such crossings.

This proposal is also made in accordance with The Highways Act 1980 Section 90A which permits a highway authority to both construct and remove road humps in a public road, for which they are the highway authority, if the highway is subject to a legal speed limit for motor vehicles of 30 miles per hour or less or the road humps are specially authorised by the Secretary of State.
