

**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL**

**(NEW SYDNEY PLACE, SYDNEY ROAD, BATHWICK) (BATH) (PROHIBITION  
OF MOTOR VEHICLES) (PROHIBITION OF PARKING AND WAITING)  
(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2024**

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 9 and section 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order: -

1. This Order comes into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024 and may be cited as the (New Sydney Place, Sydney Road, Bathwick) (Bath) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Prohibition of Parking and Waiting) (Experimental) Order 2024.
2. In this Order:-

“pedal cycle” means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels;

Prohibition of Motor Vehicles / Prohibition of Parking and Waiting

3. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to enter the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order at any time.
4. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to park and/or wait on the length of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order at any time.
5. Nothing in Articles 3 or 4 shall apply to any
  - a) any emergency service vehicle; or
  - b) any pedal cycle; or
  - c) any Council refuse vehicle being used to carry out their duties.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **Road**

### **Length**

New Sydney Place, Sydney Road, Bathwick

From its junction with Sydney Mews and Sydney Place for a distance of 5 metres in a north easterly direction.

## **SCHEDULE 2**

### **Road**

### **Length**

New Sydney Place, Sydney Road, Bathwick

From a point 5 metres north east of its junction with Sydney Mews and Sydney Place on the southern side, extending across the highway from south to north for a distance of 10 metres in a north westerly direction.

From its junction with Sydney Mews and Sydney Place on the southern side, extending across the highway from south to north for a distance of 30 metres in a north westerly direction.
