**(CHARMOUTH ROAD, LYME ROAD AND LYME GARDENS) (NEWBRIDGE)  
(BATH) (PROHIBITION OF TWO WAY TRAFFIC FLOW) (PROHIBITION OF  
PARKING AND WAITING)  
(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2024**

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 9 and section 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order: -

1. This Order comes into operation on the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2024 and may be cited as the (Charmouth Road, Lyme Road and Lyme Gardens) (Newbridge) (Bath) (Prohibition of Two Way Traffic Flow) (Prohibition of Parking and Waiting) (Experimental) Order 2024.
2. In this Order:-

“pedal cycle” means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels;

**Prohibition of Two Way Traffic**

3. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to travel in the directions and along the length of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this order.
4. Subject to Article 5, it is prohibited for any vehicle to park and/or wait on the length of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order at any time.
5. Nothing in Articles 3 or 4 shall apply to any
  - a) any emergency service vehicle; or
  - b) any pedal cycle; or non-motorised vehicles; or
  - c) any vehicle being directed by a Police Constable in uniform.

**SCHEDULE 1**

<b><u>Road</u></b>	<b><u>Prohibited Direction of Travel</u></b>
Charmouth, from its junction with A4 Newbridge Road to its junction with Lyme Road.	Southerly direction
Lyme Road, from its junction with Charmouth Road to its junction with Lyme Gardens	South easterly direction
Lyme Gardens, from its junction with Lyme Road to its junction with A4 Newbridge Road	Northerly direction

**SCHEDULE 2**

<b><u>Road</u></b>	<b><u>Length</u></b>
Charmouth Road	From a point 15 metres north of its junction with Newbridge Road for a distance of 11 metres in a northerly direction along the western kerbside.
Lyme Road	From a point 25 metres west of its junction with Charmouth Road for a distance of 9.5 metres in a westerly direction along the northern kerbside.
Lyme Gardens	From a point 6 metres south of its junction with Lyme Road for a distance of 4 metres in a southerly direction along the eastern kerbside.
