

**BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL**

**(VARIOUS ROADS, LOWER LANSDOWN) (BATH) (PRESCRIBED LEFT TURN)  
(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) (PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)  
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) (PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN)  
(REVOCAION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING)  
(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2024**

The Bath and North East Somerset Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 9 and section 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, makes the following Order: -

1. This Order comes into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024 and may be cited as the (Various Roads, Lower Lansdown) (Bath) (Prescribed Left Turn) (Prohibition of Entry) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Prohibition of Right Turn) (Prohibition of Left Turn) (Revocation of One-Way Traffic) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Experimental) Order 2024.
2. Under Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Director of Place Management or any other person authorised by them may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to be essential:-
  - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic
  - (b) in the interest of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities – or
  - (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs.
3. The restrictions in this order do not apply to a vehicle if directed by a police constable in uniform.
4. In this Order:-

“pedal cycle” means a bicycle, tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels;  
“refuse vehicle” means a local authority authorised vehicle designed for use and used solely in connection with street cleansing, the collection or disposal of refuse, or the collection or disposal of the contents of gullies or cesspools;

**Prescribed left-turn / Prohibition of Entry / Prohibition of Motor Vehicles / Prohibition of Right Turn / Prohibition of Left Turn / Revocation of One-Way Traffic / Prohibition of Waiting**

5. Subject to Article 12, every person causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed in a southerly direction in Gay Street (northern section) shall cause or permit that vehicle, on reaching the junction with George Street, to make a left turn into George Street.
6. Subject to Article 12, it is prohibited for any vehicle to enter the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this order at any time.

7. Subject to Article 12, it is prohibited for any vehicle to proceed in the length of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this order at any time.
8. Subject to Article 12, it is prohibited for any vehicle to turn right when exiting any length of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this order at any time.
9. Subject to Article 12, it is prohibited for any vehicle to turn left when exiting any length of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this order at any time.
10. The one-way Order 1558 (Various Roads, Outer Area, Bath) (General Traffic Circulation) (Consolidation) (Order 2015) is revoked permitting two-way traffic flow in the length of roads specified in Schedule 5 to this order.
11. It is prohibited for any vehicle to park and/or wait on the length of roads specified in Schedule 6 to this order at any time.
12. Nothing in Articles 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 shall apply to any
  - a) any emergency service vehicle; or
  - b) any pedal cycle; or
  - c) any Council refuse vehicle being used to carry out their duties.

**SCHEDULE 1 – Prohibition of Entry**

**SCHEDULE 2 - Prohibition of Motor Vehicles**

Catharine Place	From a point 6 metres west of its junction with River Street Mews for a distance of 2 metres in a westerly direction.

Winifred's Lane

From a point 3 metres south of its junction with Somerset Lane for a distance of approximately 72 metres in a southerly direction.

Catharine Place

On the south side from a point 1 metre west of Circus Place for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.

On the north side from a point 6 metres west of its junction with River Street Mews for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.

On the north side from a point 8 metres west of its junction with River Street Mews for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction.

Rivers Street Mews

On the west side from a point 4.5 metres north of its junction with Catharine Place for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction.

On the west side from a point 4.5 metres south of its junction with Rivers Street for a distance of 2 metres in a southerly direction.

Gay Street (northern section)

On the east side from a point 14 metres north of its junction with George Street / Gay Street (southern section) for a distance of 5 metres in a northerly direction.
