(SOUTH ROAD, TIMSBURY) (NO LEFT TURN) ORDER 2025

NOTICE is given on the **16th January 2025** that the Bath and North East Somerset Council proposes to make an order under provisions contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will introduce a “No Right Turn” restriction from Radford Hill, Timsbury into South Road, Timsbury and to introduce a “No Left Turn” restriction from South Road, Timsbury into Radford Hill, Timsbury.

Full details of the proposal are contained in the draft order which, together with a plan and a Statement of the Council’s Reasons for proposing to make the order, may be inspected at The One Stop Shops at The Hollies, High Street, Midsomer Norton, 3-4 Manvers Street, Bath and the Keynsham Civic Centre, Market Walk, Keynsham, Bath during normal office hours.
