Fairy lights



We've all been there. Finally dug out the fairy lights to adorn your tree and they aren't working. If it's not just as simple as needing a new bulb, please don't throw them in your black wheeled bin. Pop them in a bag in your green recycling box or take them to one of our household waste recycling centres and do your bit to remove them from the waste stream.

Recycling brown paper?...

Pop it in with your cardboard recycling, using your blue recycling bag.

Please do not mix with other paper recycling.

Wrapping paper

Unfortunately, we are unable to recycle your wrapping paper. Over the last couple of years the recycling market has significantly changed. We have always been fortunate to secure UK markets for our paper collected in B&NES. However, a huge proportion of paper from the UK was being exported until recent years. The drive to recycle more material closer to home has meant paper mills can demand higher quality.

Why not choose to wrap the pressies you give this year in something reusable or recyclable? You could use bright material, brown paper or even a colourful magazine - all of which can be reused or recycled.

Greetings cards

Please put any greetings cards into your green recycling box and let them live on and become new paper, or packaging.

We can't collect cards with glitter on as this contaminates the recycling stream. You can tear off the glittery part and put this in your wheeled bin and put the rest in your green box along with your other paper recycling.


