

NOTICE OF MADE ORDER

SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA8/84, CULVERHAY, COMPTON DANDO) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order the effect of which will temporarily close the section of Public Footpath BA8/84, Compton Dando, commencing from a junction with Culverhay at grid reference ST 6471 6470 (point A on the order map) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 60 metres to grid reference ST 6475 6475 (point B on the order map).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely Land and Water Services are proposing essential flume works. The Order will come into force on 1st June 2024 and will be effective for 6 months. The closure will only be effective during the period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is anticipated to be for **14 weeks**.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE - northwards along Culverhay for approximately 22 metres to a permissive path - Vice Versa.

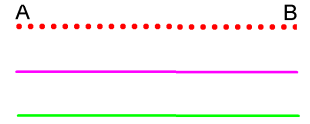
